

Come To Me — Matthew 11:28–30

Jesus Sees Our Weariness

Matthew 11:28

- Jesus sees physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual weariness.
- Jesus sees the burdens people often hide from others.
- Jesus does not minimize our burdens — He invites us to bring them to Him.
- We carry things Jesus never intended for us to carry alone.

Main Truth: Jesus does not ignore the weary — He invites them close.

Jesus Gives Rest To The Lost Sinner

Matthew 11:28–30

- The deepest burden we carry is sin.
- Jesus carried our guilt, shame, and judgment to the cross.
- Salvation is not earned through performance or striving.
- Jesus gives forgiveness, grace, peace, and rest for the soul.

Main Truth: Jesus gives rest to burdened souls.

Saved People Still Need To Come To Jesus

Philippians 4:6–7

1 Peter 5:7

Psalm 55:22

- Coming to Jesus is not only the start of faith — it is the rhythm of faith.
- The Christian life was never meant to be lived apart from dependence on Jesus.
- Scripture repeatedly tells us to bring our burdens to God.
- Dependence on Jesus is not weakness — it is discipleship.

Main Truth: We come to Jesus to be saved, and we keep coming to Jesus to be sustained.

Jesus Provides What We Need

Psalm 34:10

Philippians 4:19

- Jesus may not always provide what we want, but He always provides what we need.
- Sometimes God provides answers; sometimes He provides sustaining grace.
- Peace, wisdom, strength, and endurance are found in His presence.
- The answer to weariness is staying close to Jesus.

Main Truth: Jesus always provides what is necessary, sustaining, and good.

Come To The Shepherd

Psalm 23

- Jesus is not only our Savior — He is our Shepherd.
- The Shepherd restores, comforts, leads, and sustains His people.
- Even in difficult seasons, we are never abandoned.
- Jesus is enough to save us and sustain us.

Main Truth: Jesus is the Shepherd who restores weary souls.

Reflective Questions

- What burden or weariness am I carrying right now?
- Have I been trying to carry things in my own strength instead of bringing them to Jesus?
- Am I staying close to Jesus or simply striving harder?
- What is Jesus inviting me to surrender today?
