Connect Questions:

1. Why do you think this man in v. 57 came to commit to following Jesus? Do you remember a time in your life when you followed Jesus for the wrong or skewed reasons? How did you grow from that experience?

2. What does it really mean to "count the cost" of discipleship? What does that or should that look like in the Church today? In your life?

3. What reason did the man in v. 59 have for delaying? Why was it not a valid reason? What reasons do you have for delaying in something you are called by the LORD to? Is it a valid reason?

4. What are some things that can distract us from being "sold out" for Jesus? Can you think of a time in your life when you "turned with your hand on the plow" and "got burned"? How can we remain focused on Him and His will?
