Connect Questions:

- 1. Why do you think the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray? Does it surprise you at all that His model prayer is so short? Why or Why not?
- 2. Jesus taught them to pray Our Father...how was that surprising in the culture? Do we realize what that means for us? At what cost were we made His children?
- 3. Why does it matter that God is in heaven? That He is El Olam & El Shaddai? What does it mean that God is Hallowed? Why does it matter?
- 4. What is the Kingdom of God? How can we invite His kingdom into our lives and what does that mean or should it mean?
- 5. Are we Thy Will people or My Will people? What does the kingdom look like in heaven? How can we allow it to look like that in our daily lives?
