3. Why did Jesus choose a donkey and what does that mean for us? Are you submitted to Jesus on a daily basis? Why or Why not?
4. How did the people worship Jesus and what did it mean? Why did He want to be praised? What place does worship have in your daily life? How can we grow in worship?
