


### HEBREUS JESUS IS GREATER








3) Every transgression or


disobedience received a just

"transgression" refers to the willful and intentional violation of specific commands (active)

"disobedience" suggests omission, doing nothing when we should do something (passive)

### Neglect

• amelēsantes - to make light of, ignore, treat carelessly, or neglect

 to avoid what you know is right, not take care of, children; a garden (abandon)
