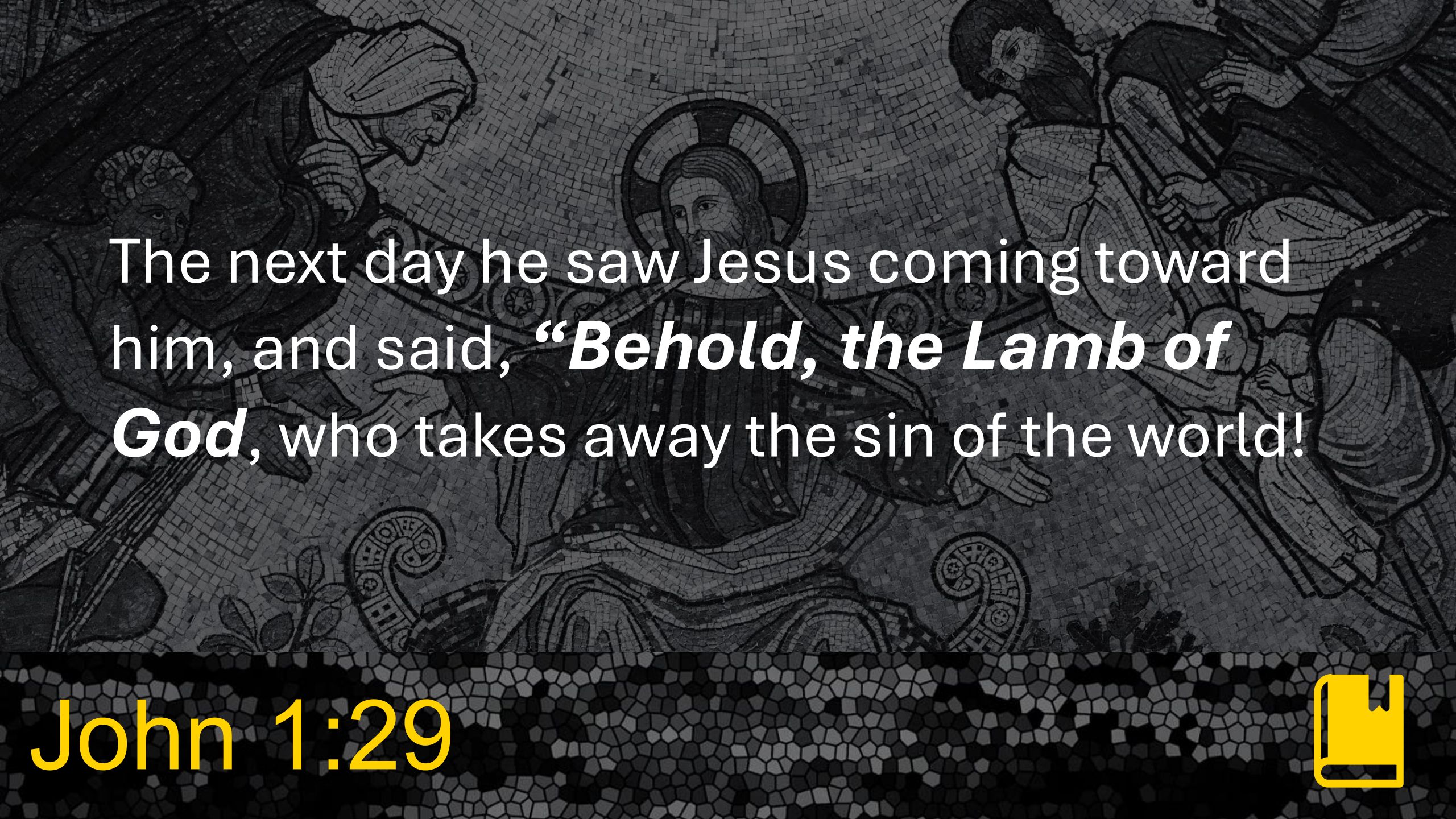
HAPI – god of the Nile

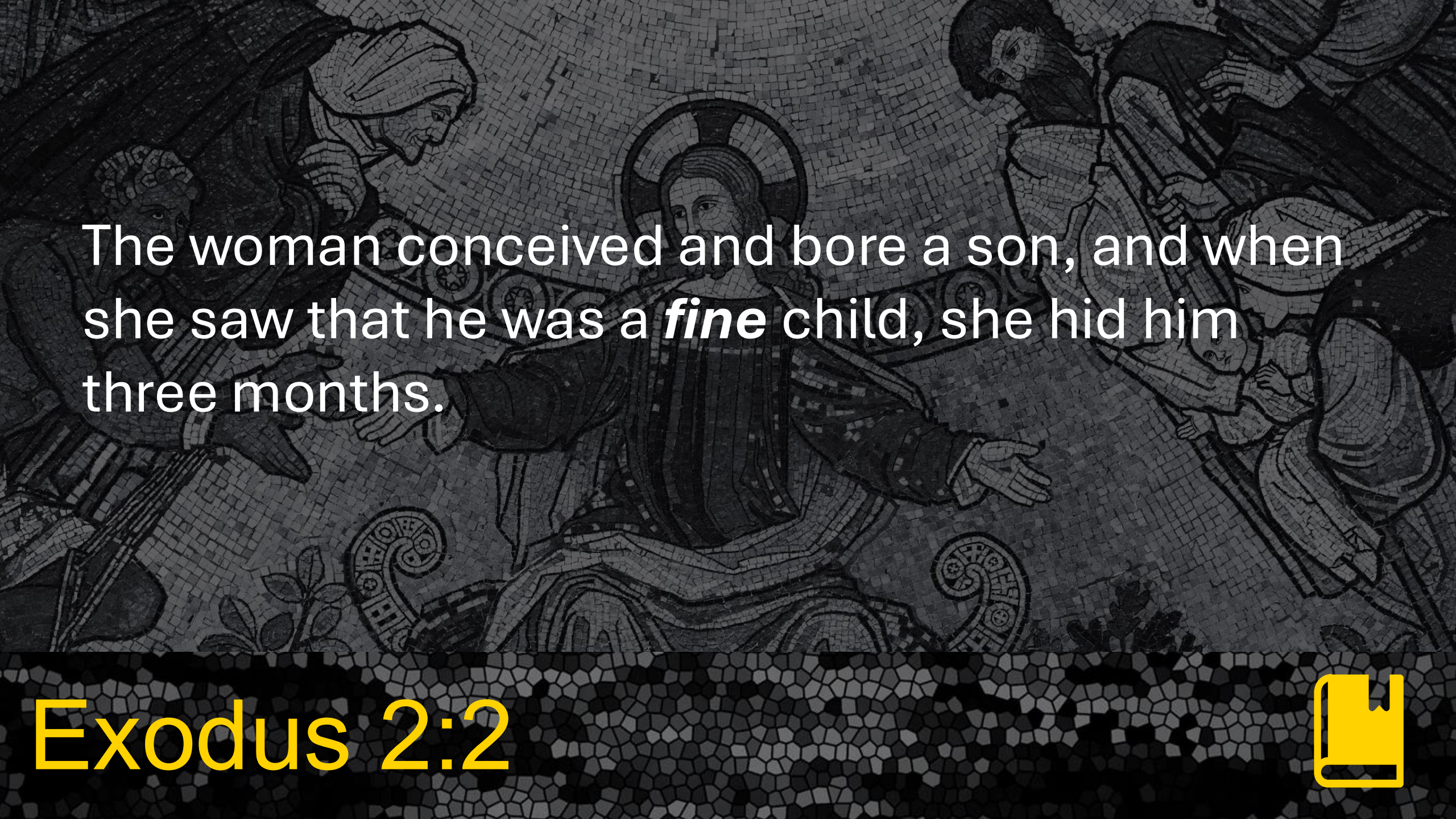




¹ Then Moses and the people of Israel sang this song to the Lord, saying,
