**Judges 6:19 - 21 (NKJV)** <sup>19</sup>So Gideon went in and prepared a young goat, and unleavened bread from an ephah of flour. The meat he put in a basket, and he put the broth in a pot; and he brought them out to Him under the terebinth tree and presented them. <sup>20</sup>The Angel of God said to him, "Take the meat and the unleavened bread and lay them on this rock and pour out the broth." And he did so. <sup>21</sup>Then the Angel of the Lord put out the end of the staff that was in His hand and touched the meat and the unleavened bread; And the Angel of the Lord departed out of his sight.

**Judges 6:36-40 (NKJV)** <sup>36</sup>So Gideon said to God, "If You will save Israel by my hand as You have said— <sup>37</sup>look, I shall put a fleece of wool on the threshing floor; if there is dew on the fleece only, and it is dry on all the ground, then I shall know that You will save Israel by my hand, as You have said." Or as I think I've heard you say to me <sup>38</sup>And it was so. When he rose early the next morning and squeezed the fleece together, he wrung the dew out of the fleece, a bowlful of water. <sup>39</sup>Then Gideon said to God, "Do not be angry with me, but let me speak just once more: Let me test, I pray, just once more with the fleece; let it now be dry only on the fleece, but on all the ground let there be dew." <sup>40</sup>And God did so that night. It was dry on the fleece only, but there was dew on all the ground.
