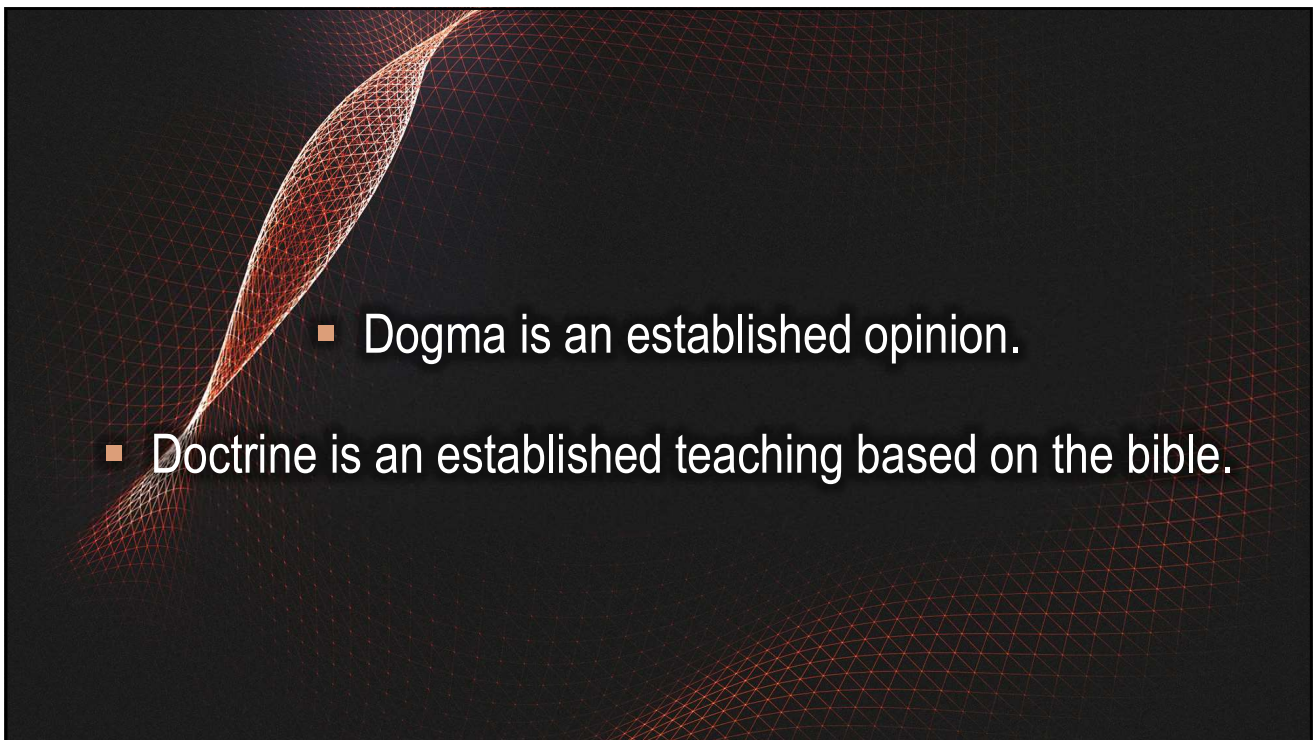


**Psalms 98:8 (NKJV)** Let the rivers clap their hands; let the hills be joyful together before the Lord.


