Psalms 95:1 (NKJV) Oh come, let us sing to the Lord! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation.


Psalms 96:1 (NKJV) Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! Sing to the Lord, all the earth.

Hebrews 2:12 (NKJV) saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly, I will sing praise to You."










Psalms 63:4 (NKJV) Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your Name.
