



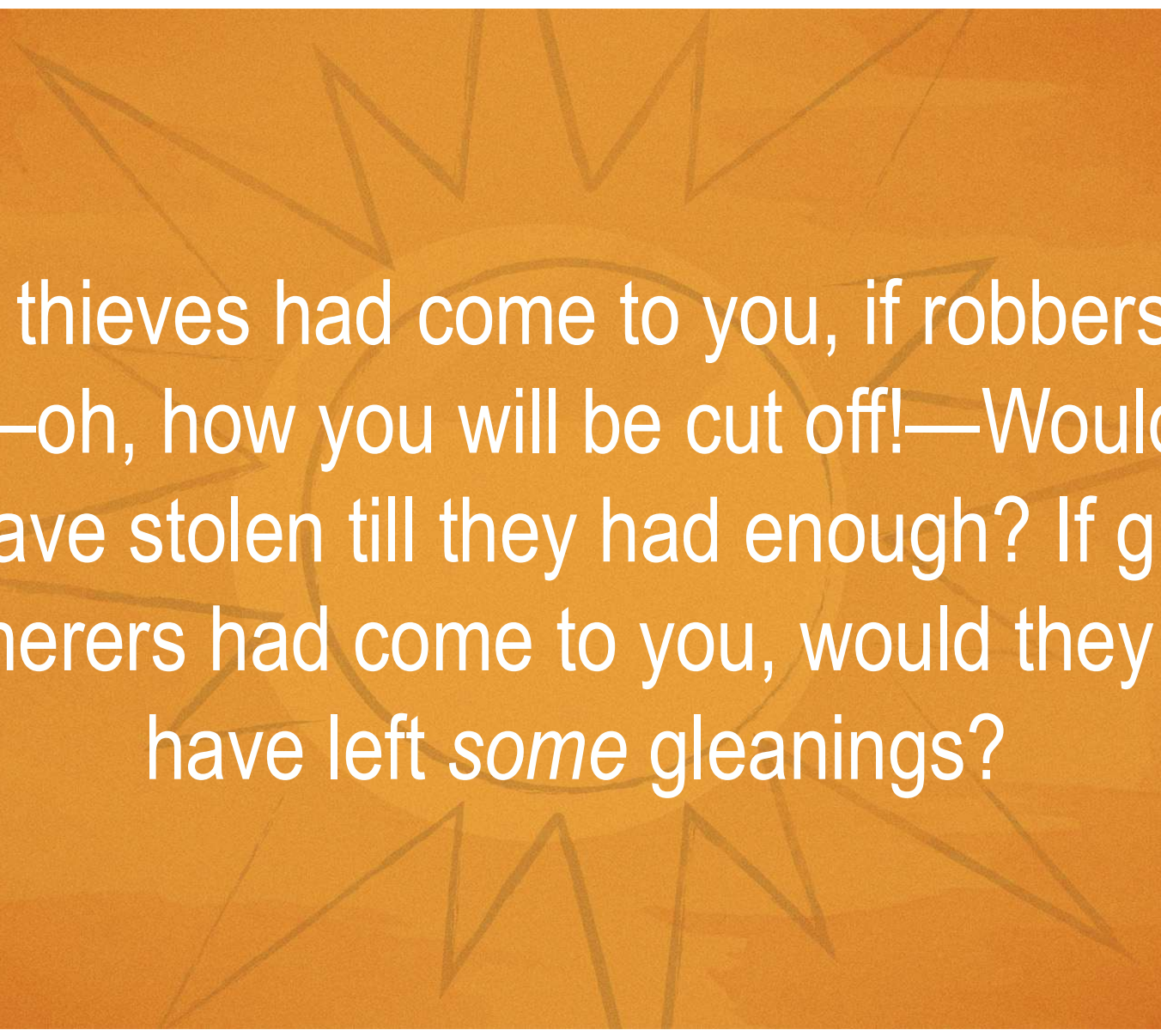

PROPHETS OF RIGHT REVELATION

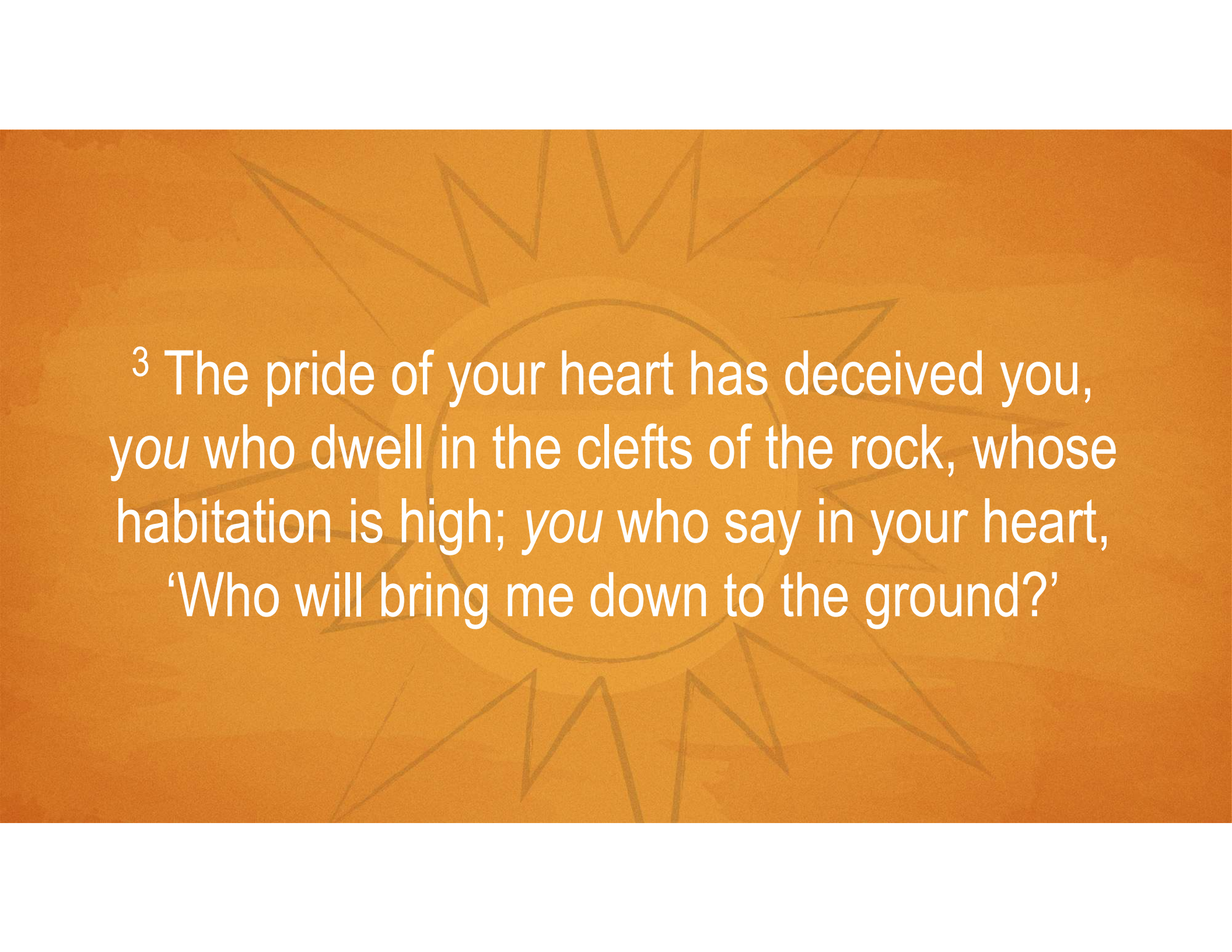
Obadiah 1–9 (NKJV) ¹ The vision of Obadiah. Thus says the Lord GOD concerning Edom (We have heard a report from the LORD, and a messenger has been sent among the nations, *saying*, “Arise, and let us rise up against her for battle”) ² “Behold, I will make you small among the nations; you shall be greatly despised. ³ The pride of your heart has deceived you. *You* who dwell in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; *you* who say in your heart, ‘Who will bring me down to the ground?’

Obadiah 1–9 (NKJV) ⁴ Though you ascend as high as the eagle, and though you set your nest among the stars, from there I will bring you down,” says the LORD. ⁵ “If thieves had come to you, if robbers by night— oh, how you will be cut off!— Would they not have stolen till they had enough? If grape-gatherers had come to you, Would they not have left *some* gleanings? ⁶ “Oh, how Esau shall be searched out! *How* his hidden treasures shall be sought after!

Obadiah 1–9 (NKJV) ⁷ All the men in your confederacy shall force you to the border; the men at peace with you shall deceive you *and* prevail against you. *Those who eat your bread* shall lay a trap for you. No one is aware of it. ⁸ “Will I not in that day,” says the LORD, “Even destroy the wise *men* from Edom, and understanding from the mountains of Esau? ⁹ Then your mighty men, o Teman, shall be dismayed, to the end that everyone from the mountains of Esau may be cut off by slaughter.

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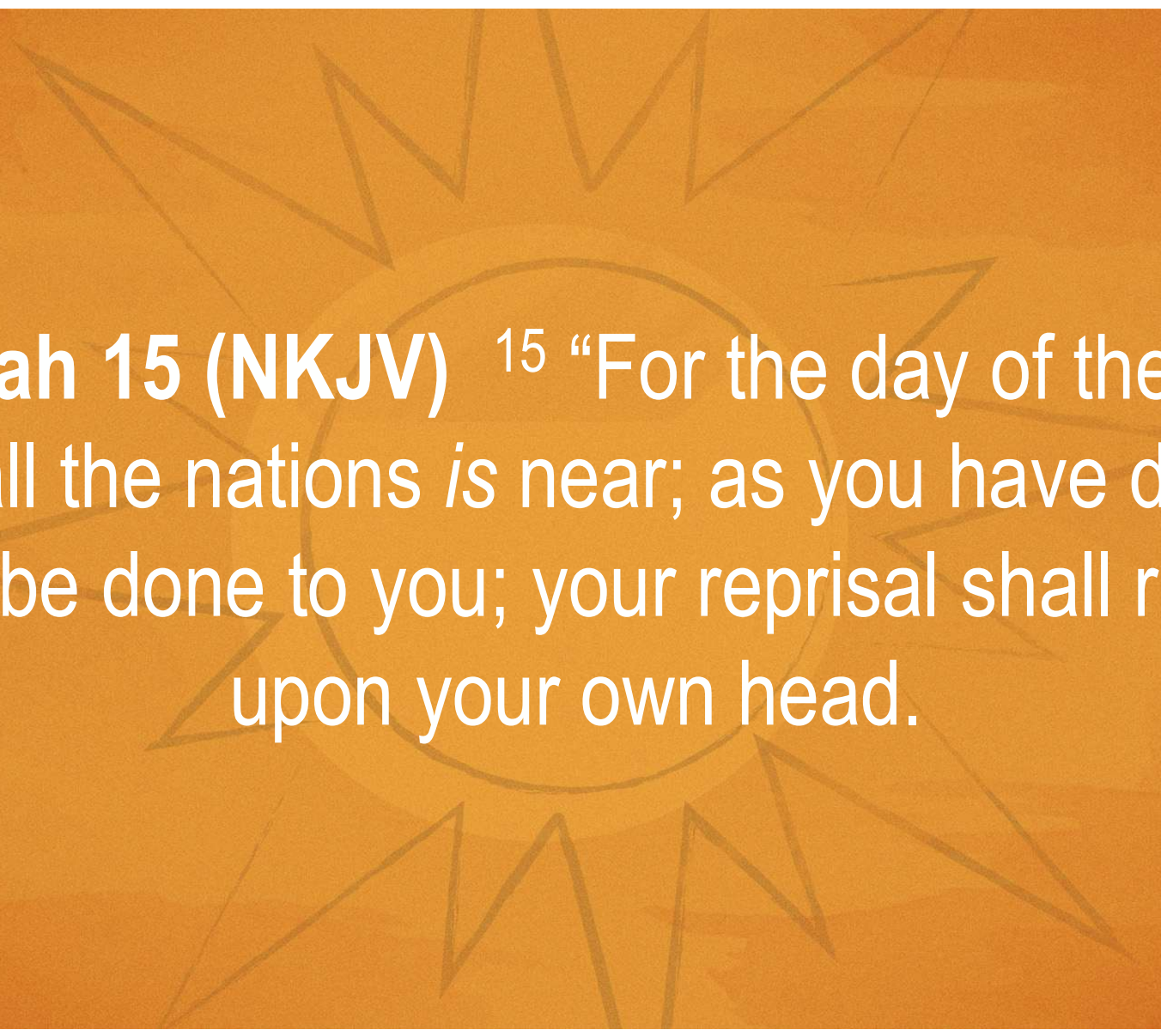


Al siq - main trail

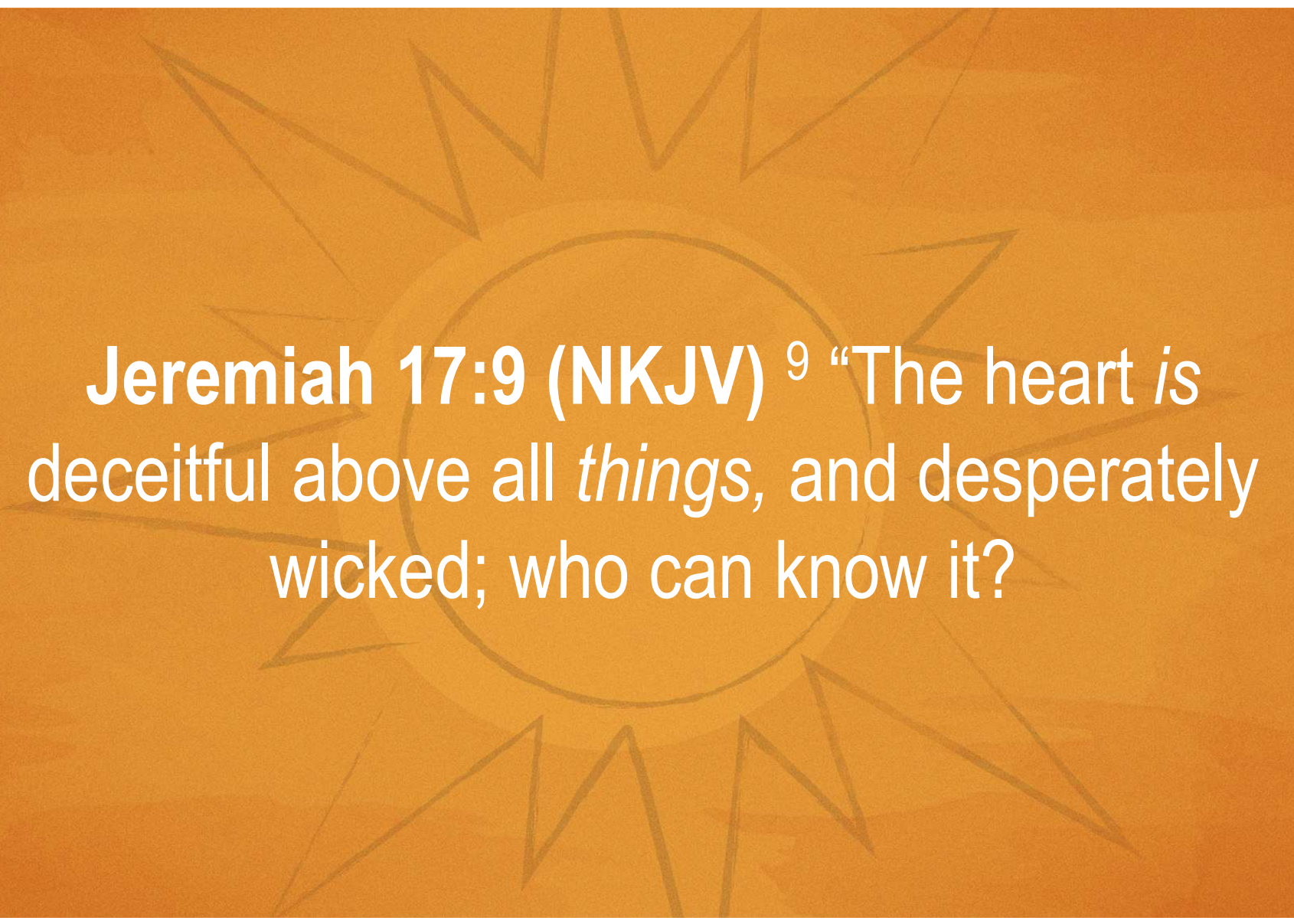

ROUGH SUBDIVISION OF OBADIAH PROPHECY CONCERNING EDOM'S DESTRUCTION.

1. Its certainty - vv 1 to 9
2. Its cause - vv 10 to 14
3. The climax of destruction - vv 15 to 16
4. The consolation - vv 17- 21
