Exodus 13:4-5 (NKJV) ⁴On this day you are going out, in the month Abib. ⁵And it shall be, **when the LORD brings you into the land of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, which He swore to your fathers to give you**, a land flowing with milk and honey, that you shall keep this service in this month.

Exodus 13:17 -18 (NKJV) ¹⁷Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that **God did not lead them *by way* of the land of the Philistines, although that *was* near; for God said, “Lest perhaps the people change their minds when they see war and return to Egypt.”** ¹⁸So God led the people around *by way* of the wilderness of the Red Sea. And the children of Israel went up in orderly ranks out of the land of Egypt.



Exodus 14:1 - 2 (NKJV) ¹Now the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: ²“Speak to the children of Israel, that they turn and camp before Pi Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, opposite Baal Zephon; you shall camp before it by the **sea**.”



Exodus 13:21-22 (NKJV) ²¹And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night. ²²He did not take away the pillar.



Exodus 14:9-10 (NKJV) ⁹So the Egyptians pursued them, all the horses *and* chariots of Pharaoh, his horsemen and his army, and overtook them camping by the sea beside Pi Hahiroth, before Baal Zephon ¹⁰And when Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted their eyes, **and behold, the Egyptians marched after them so they were very afraid, and the children of Israel cried out to the LORD.**



Exodus 14:11-12 (NKJV) ¹¹Then they said to Moses, “Because *there were* no graves in Egypt, have you taken us away to die in the wilderness? Why have you so dealt with us, to bring us up out of Egypt? ¹²Is this not the word that we told you in Egypt, saying, ‘Let us alone that we may serve the Egyptians’? For *it would have been* better for us to serve the Egyptians than that we should die in the wilderness.”
