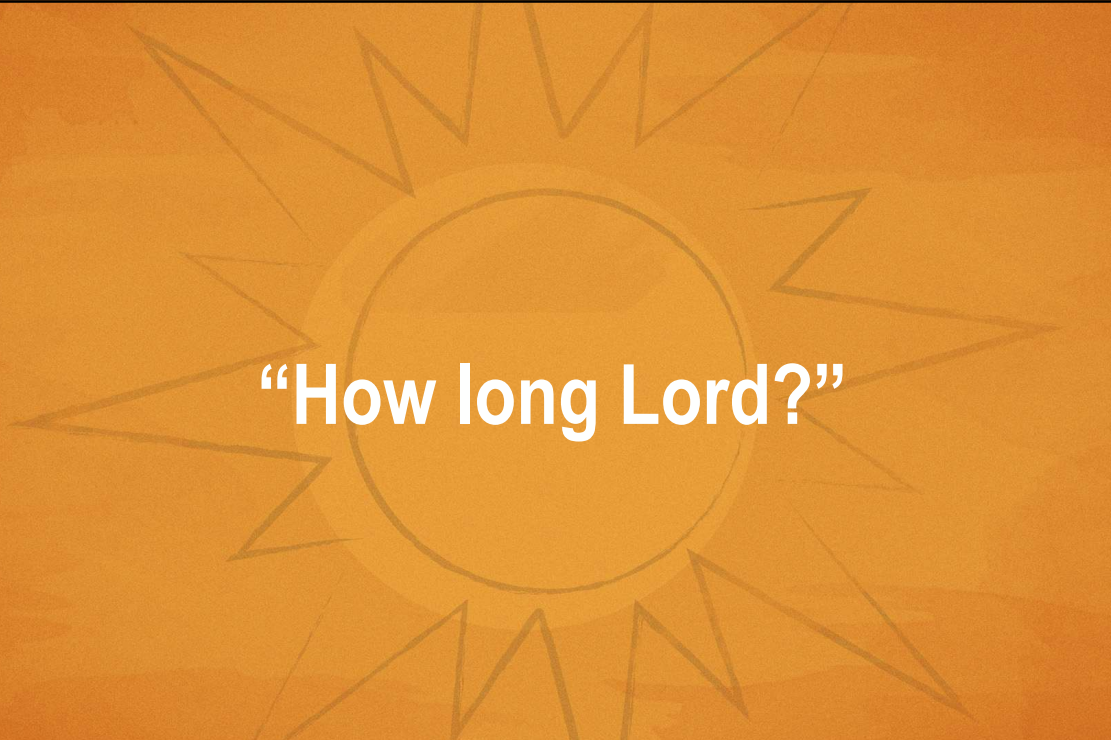
1 Corinthians 6:19 NIV – ¹⁹Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?

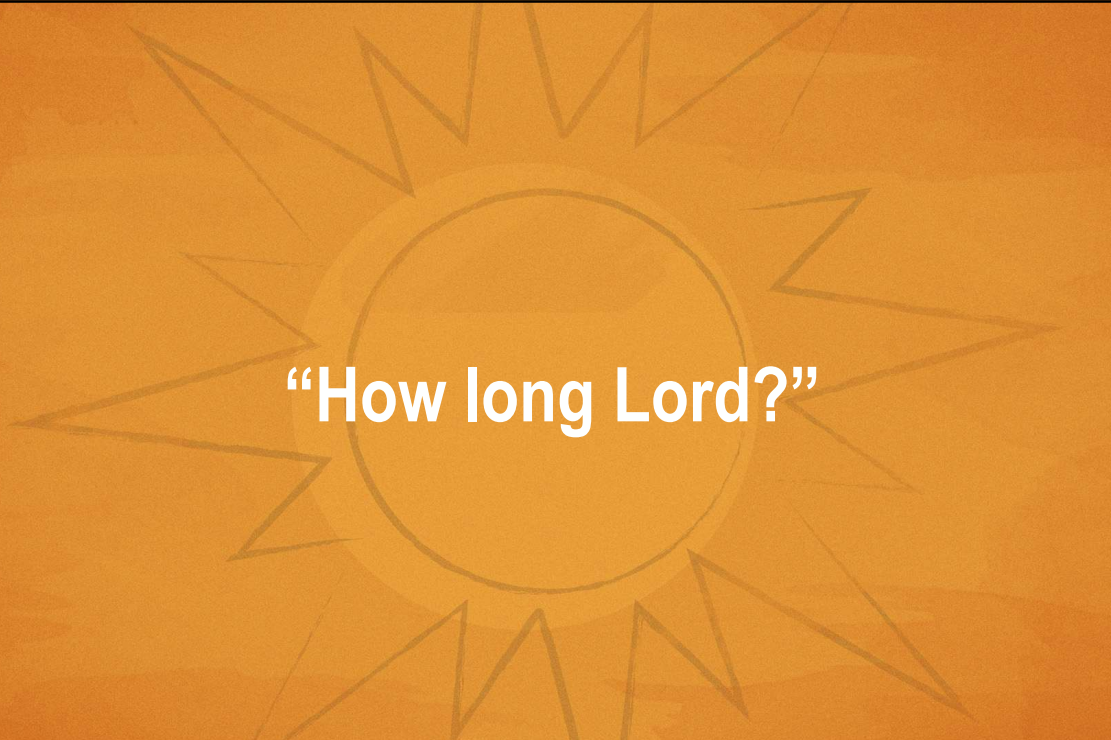

Why do you tolerate wrongdoing? Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and conflict abounds. ⁴Therefore the law is paralyzed, and justice never prevails. 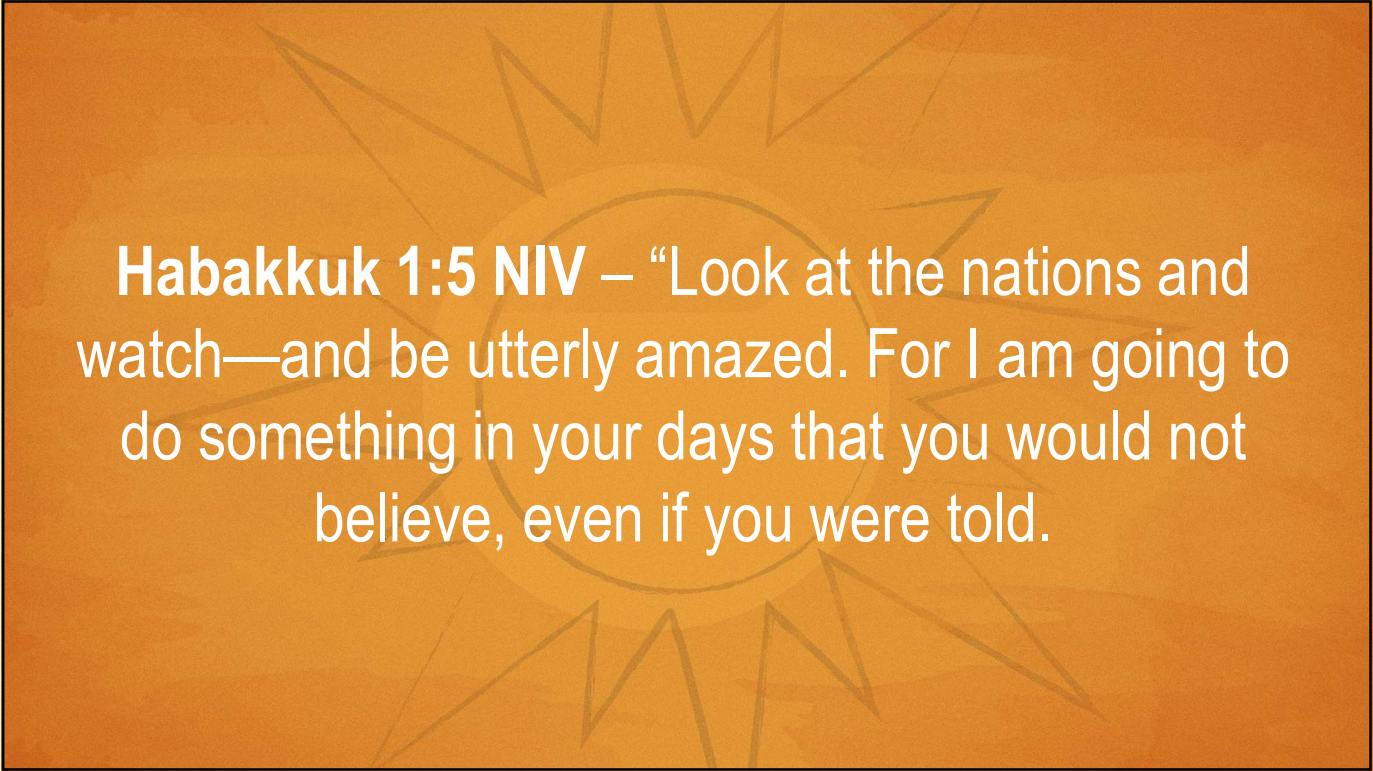


“How long Lord?”

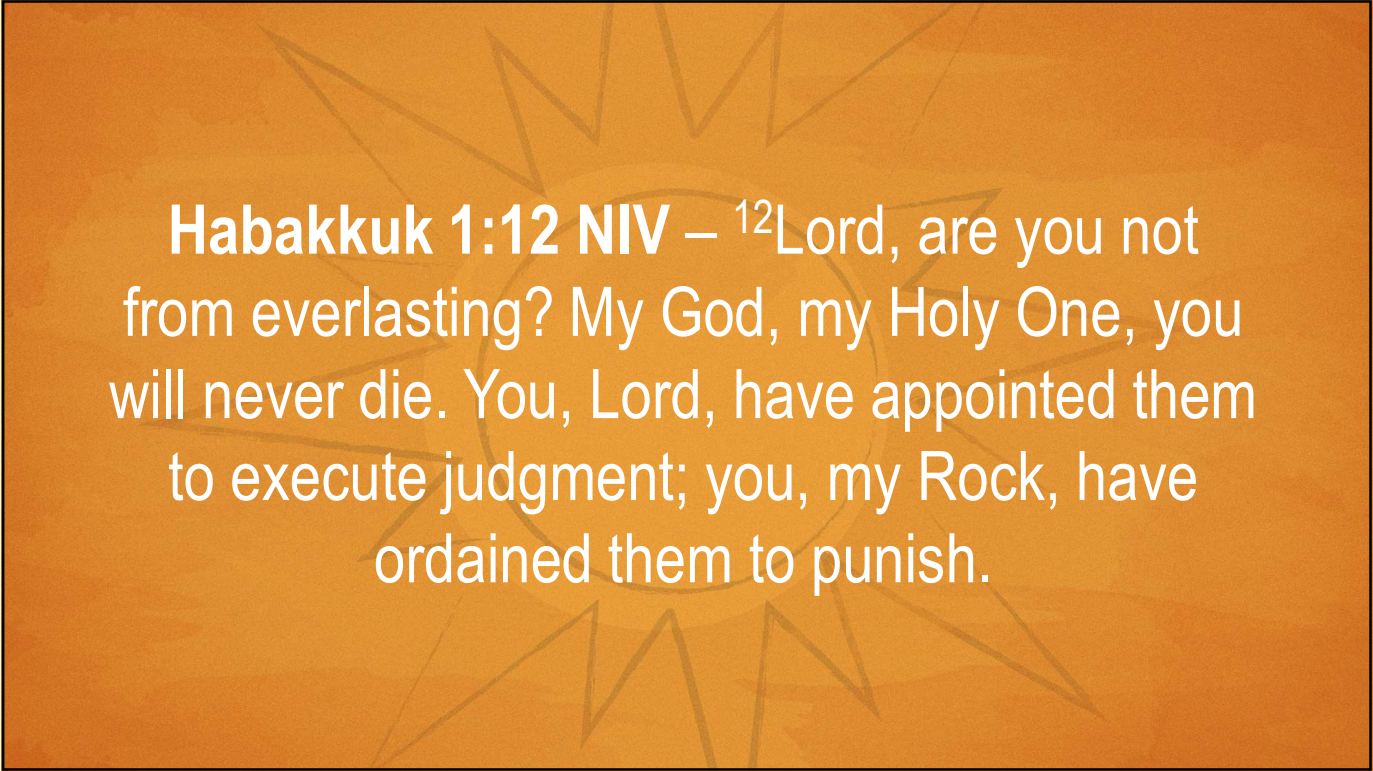
Habakkuk 1:5 NIV – “Look at the nations and watch—and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told.
