**Joel 2:1 (NKJV)** - Blow the [a]trumpet in Zion and sound an alarm

for the day of the Lord is coming, for it is at hand:

**Joel 2:11 (NKJV)** - The Lord gives voice before His army,  
for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word.

who can endure it?

**Joel 2:31 (NKJV)** - The sun shall be turned into darkness,  
and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and

**Joel 2:12-14 (NKJV)** - <sup>12</sup> “Now, therefore,” says the Lord,  
“Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and  
with mourning.” <sup>13</sup> So rend your heart, and not your garments;  
return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and merciful,  
slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing

**Joel 2:15-27 (NKJV)** – <sup>15</sup> Blow the trumpet in Zion, consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; <sup>16</sup> Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders gather the children and nursing babes; let the bridegroom go out from his chamber, and the bride from her dressing room. <sup>17</sup> Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, weep between the porch and the altar; let them say, “Spare Your people, O Lord, and do not give Your heritage to reproach that the nations should rule over them. Why should they say among the peoples ‘Where is their God?’ ”

**Joel 2:15-27 (NKJV)** – <sup>18</sup> Then the Lord will be zealous for His land and pity His people. <sup>19</sup> The Lord will answer and say to His people, “Behold, I will send you grain and new wine and oil, and you will be satisfied by them; I will no longer make you a reproach among the nations. <sup>20</sup> “But I will remove far from you the northern army and will drive him away into a barren and desolate land, with his face toward the eastern sea and his back toward the western sea; his stench will come up, and his foul odor will rise, because he has done monstrous things.”
