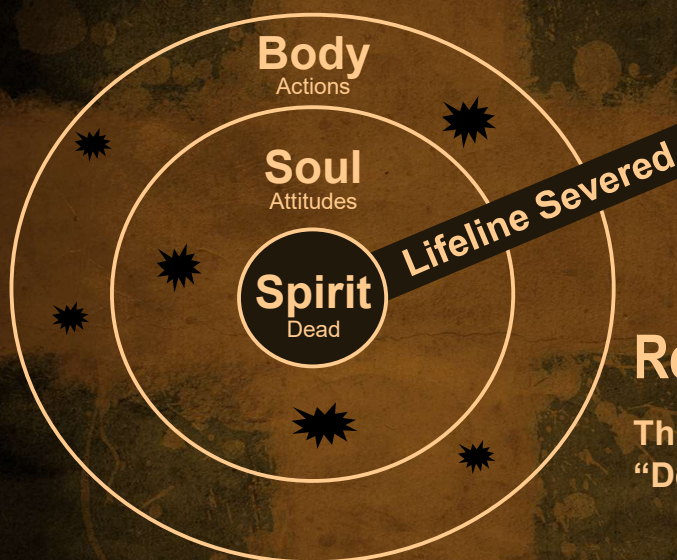
## THE CONDITION OF MAN BEFORE THE FALL

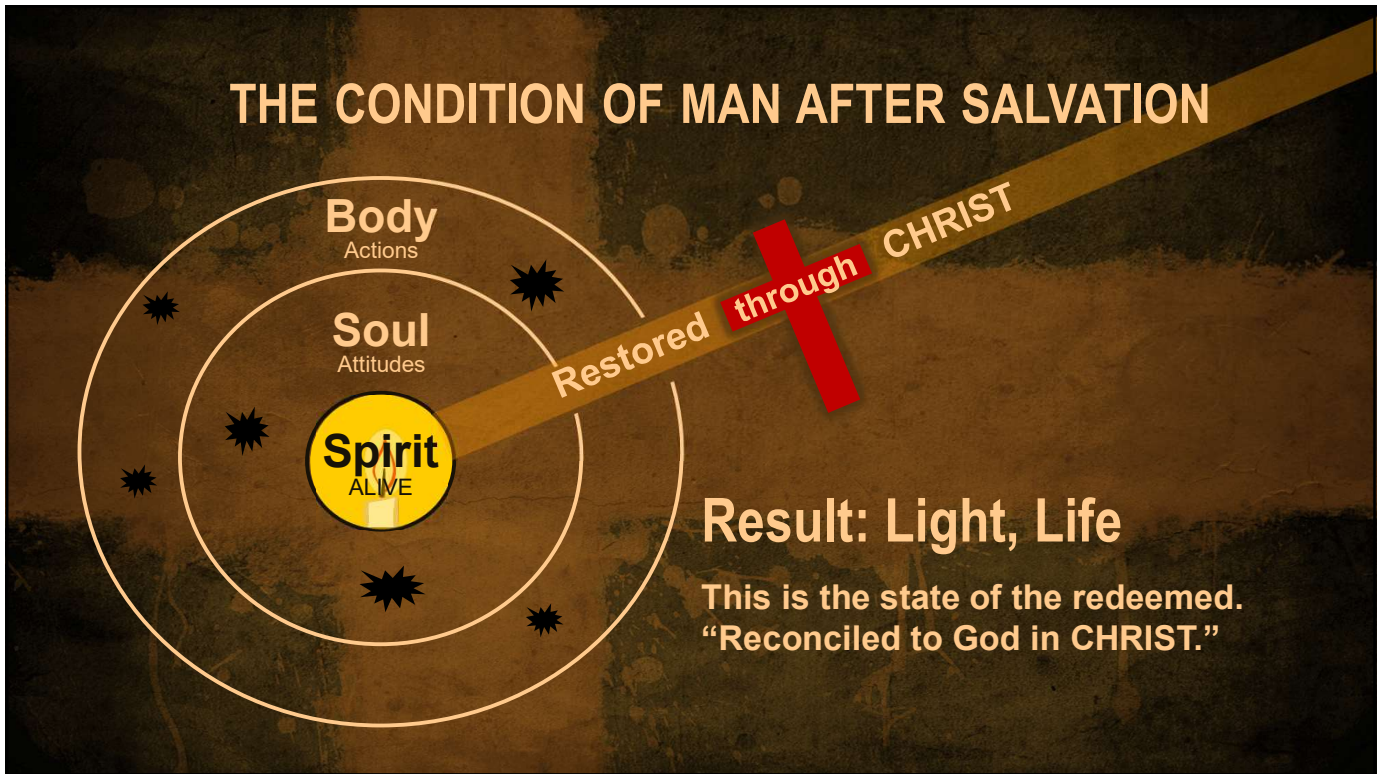
## THE CONDITION OF MAN AFTER THE FALL
