
**Romans 3:25 (NKJV)** <sup>25</sup> whom God set forth as a propitiation ...

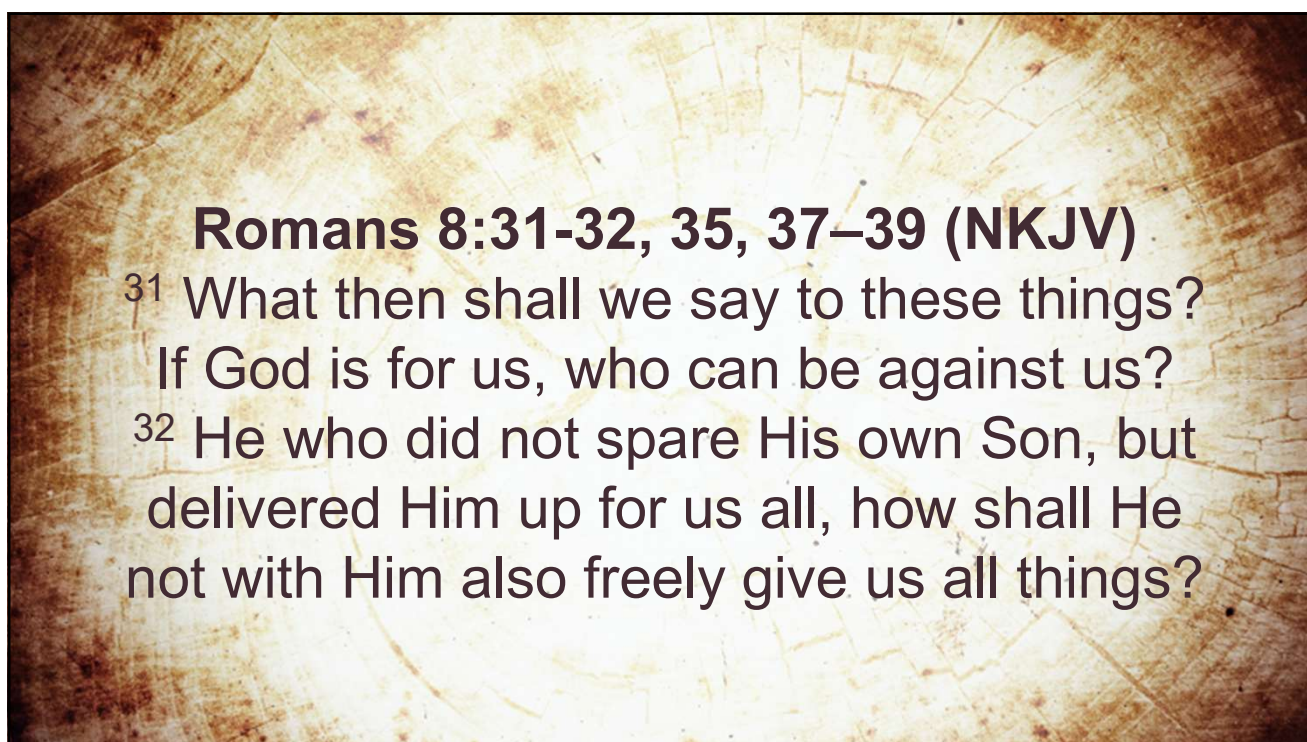
