8. Read John 4:24. How is worshipping God “in spirit and truth” related to worshipping God not with mere outward forms and rituals of worship, but worshipping Him from your *heart*?

a. How can you discern if your heart is not engaged in worship while singing songs of worship at church?

b. How will you grow in expressing worship through singing worship songs together at church?
