 - a. What is the *result* of sin that I won't work through in my life?
- 6. Read Hosea 8:8 along with John 15:5 and Romans 8:8. Why am I useless to God when I rely on myself instead of Him?
 - a. Why is *prayerlessness* an excellent indicator of depending on *myself*?
 - b. In what ways do you tend to rely on yourself instead of God?
