Deuteronomy 6:4-9

- 1. Why is a message on parenting important for people who don't have children?
- 2. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-5 and explain what the highest priority should be for children?
 - a. How do parents communicate *something else* is a higher priority than loving God?
 - b. Parents how are you doing at communicating to your kids what your *highest priority* for them is? Explain.
- 3. Loving God cannot occur apart from faith (Romans 14:23; Hebrews 11:6). According to Romans 10:17 *where* does faith come from?
- 4. Read Deuteronomy 6:5 and Colossians 3:16 and explain the importance of *your personal* intake of God's word before you can help others (children etc...).
 - a. Assess your time in God's word... Are you happy with your devotion to it? If not what do you plan to change *with God's help* starting tomorrow? Be specific.

5. Read Deuteronomy 6:7-9 and explain what is said about a parent's role in building their kids' faith.
