c. What is the significance of focusing on the fact that “God” positioned these people in your life?

3. Read Esther 2:7-18. What evidence do we see for God placing Esther where she ends up?

a. What is disturbing about the process that the women are legally forced to go through?

b. Read Psalm 119:91 and Isaiah 46:9-11. Why is it critical to recognize that God works through “excessive government intervention” and “very bad legislation” as Jon Bloom says?

c. What happens to a Christian when they obsess over a bad policy while losing sight of God's sovereignty?

d. How are you doing with the changes in laws in our nation over the past decade?

4. Read Esther 2:19-23. What evidence do we see for God placing Mordecai where he did?

a. What does it look like for you to be eager to be positioned by God to bless another?

b. Name 5 people God has positioned you to uniquely impact.

c. Why is it a thrill to know God is using ME in someone else's life?
