

4 Responses to the Gospel

Mark 4:1-20

- 1. Read Mark 4:1-13. Why will the disciples gain greater understanding about Jesus' parable (in verse 14-20) according to v. 10?
 - a. What does this tell us about their hearts?
 - b. In this parable, Jesus compares 4 types of soils to 4 types of heart-responses to the gospel (seeds). Why is your response to the gospel (as a lost person or a believer) <u>always</u> dependent on the state of your heart?
- 2. According to verses 14-15 what occurs with the "Hardened Soil Listener"?
 - a. How is the "gospel" ("the word") like "seed"?
 - b. Why do you think Jesus wants you to understand <u>Satan's</u> involvement in keeping people from God's truth?
- 3. According to verses 16-17 what happens with the "Rocky Soil Listener"?
 - a. How do verses 5-6 give further insight?
 - b. According to the sermon how is a "Rocky Soil Listener" like a consumer who gets "buyer's remorse"?
 - c. What types of "Christian" things might a Rocky Soil Listener do at first?
 - d. How do we know this person never actually accepted Jesus by faith? See v. 17 and v. 6.

- e. Are there any difficult stands or sacrifices you've been struggling to make for Jesus lately? Explain and then pray for help.
- 4. According to verses 18-19 what is going on in the heart of a "Thorny Soil Listener?
 - a. If someone is a Thorny Soil Listener, what may be motivating them to keep making objections against Christianity?
 - b. What is something in the world that has be tempting you to get your eyes off Jesus lately?
 - c. What is the BIG LIE that we're told regarding money in our society (cf. v. 19 "deceitfulness of riches")?
 - d. How are you specifically tempted to believe the BIG LIE about money?
 - e. How does a proper understanding of who Jesus is, and what He's accomplished for you free you from craving for worldly pleasures and things?
- 5. According to verse 20 how is the "Fertile Soil Listener" different from the other 3 soils/ hearts?
 - a. What soil condition (heart condition) of the 3 is most tempting for you right now? Why?
 - b. What do you need to do to keep the soil of your heart fertile for God's truth?
 - c. Write down some spiritual fruit that God has brought about in your life since you've been following Jesus.
