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c. Why should you be excited for God to keep teaching you?

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d. Why is it significant that God doesn't teach in a general way – but He personalizes His teaching to each of those trusting in Him?

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e. Why are you comforted by trusting that God promises to “counsel” you? How should this impact deep patterns of sin you’ve yet to get over?

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f. What does it mean for God to have His “eye upon you”?

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- c. Isaiah 62:5
