Pastor Ted gave us a very good sermon on Paul's concern for the Galatians. There are two ways that they could have assurance in their salvation: Dependence and Weakness. So let's chat a bit about assurance and where theirs, and ours also comes from!

- 1) What did the Galatians start doing in 4:10 that was an issue with Paul? What was Paul's thoughts about what they started practicing? What is the real cause for distress by Paul with their practices?
- 2) For those who have listened to the sermon; after we accept Jesus into our lives, what is our tendency afterwards? What is it like to be able to lean on Jesus' resume instead of ours?
- 3) What are some sure fire ways to kill our confidence in Jesus' resume? How can your performance change your peace in Jesus? What should give us true peace?
- 4) What was the tactic used by the false teachers to encourage the Galatians into practicing the laws? Why would Paul call them "like little children"?
- 5) Proverbs 27:6, Proverbs 28:23, and Romans 12:2. What does the Bible say about flattery and how we can prepare for when false prophets arise?

Galatians can feel a bit repetitive at times, but it is for our good. To understand that our resume is in Christ Jesus alone, and that if we try and try to stack up we will fail every time. What more reason to boast 2 Corinthians 11:30 "If I must boast, then I will boast in the things that show my weakness"
