Main Point: God reconciled believers to Himself through Jesus Christ

1. Our Need for Reconciliation

Jason began by reminding us that reconciliation starts with recognizing our greatest need.

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:18–19

- Why is reconciliation with God necessary?
- How does sin affect our relationship with God?
- Why is it important to remember that we could not reconcile ourselves?

2. Our Mission as Ambassadors

God's plan doesn't stop with saving us. Every believer has been given the responsibility of ambassadorship.

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:20

- What does it mean to be an "ambassador for Christ"?
- Who has God placed in your life that needs to hear the message of reconciliation?
- What keeps you from sharing your faith, and how can the group pray for you?

3. God's Solution Through Christ

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:21

- What does verse 21 teach us about what Jesus accomplished on the cross?
- How does knowing Christ took our sin and gave us His righteousness change the way you view your salvation?
- What encourages you most about God taking the initiative to save us?

4. Living Reconciled Lives

As people who have experienced God's grace, we are called to pursue peace, extend forgiveness, and faithfully represent Christ in our relationships and everyday lives.

- How can our community group better reflect the ministry of reconciliation in our communities together?
- What is one specific step you will take this week to live as Christ's ambassador?
