Message: James Risner Questions: John Brewer

This week, James Risner, chair of the Greater Dayton Association of Baptists, visited us to share God's word. James taught from Acts 2:42-47 which is a snapshot of God working in and through the early Church. James focused on two main points from the passage.

- 1. The church Jesus builds devotes herself to God's ordinary means of grace (v. 42)
- 2. The church Jesus builds delights herself in God's extraordinary work (vv. 43-47)

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What do we think of when we hear a church is being "built?" How does Jesus build his church?
- 2. James introduced the idea of "ordinary means of grace." What are they and what makes them "ordinary?" (Reference Acts 2:42).
- 3. Why is preaching and studying the Bible such a big priority?
- 4. What do we need from the Church, and how does that contrast with what people often want? Reference 2 Timothy 4:1-5.
- 5. Why is Jesus' act of building community through the church miraculous? How does this point to future promises from God? What bound the early church together? What binds us together?
- 6. What causes a church like ours to grow (reference v 47)?
