The music used during the distribution of Communion are two cultural Communion hymns. "The Bread of Life for All Is Broken", by Yin-Lan Su, cpr. 1989 The United Methodist Publishing House, is a Chinese hymn that is in Hymns of Universal Praise as one of the fifty indigenous hymns in this hymnal from 1936 that was used by many denominations.

"Come, Let Us Eat" is a Loma hymn from Liberia, written by Billema Kwillia in the 1960s, and learned to "read her own Loma language through a church literacy program" This hymn is also found in the Communion section of our hymnal.
