Today's Message: Soul Saving Questions – We <u>must</u> not hide God's truth from the next generation.

LEARNING TOGETHER

1. The Text Joshua 4:1-24

God's plan reveale	d – God spoke to Joshua with a plan to future generations.
4:1-3	" the LORD spoke to Joshua <u>Take you hence</u> out of Jordan"
Twelve men chosen – Joshua told the that the stones would be for a memorial.	
4:4-7	"Then Joshua called the twelve men whom he had prepared"
Twelve stones twice – Joshua set up his own future of twelve stones in Jordan.	
4:8-9	"Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place"
Every thing finished – The priests were faithful to until Joshua said, "Come ye up."	
4:10-18	"priests stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished"
God's plan taught -	- Joshua pitched the twelve stones and taught them it was done.
4:19-24	"When your children shall ASK saying, What mean these stones?"

2. The History Exodus 12:26 (Children's Questions); Exodus 12:3 (Lambs taken)

- **Children** — This memorial of twelve stones is 1 of 4 instances called out in the Scriptures as questions that **will** be asked of their children. The others are the Passover

service, the redemption of first-born children, and God's written Word. *Exodus 12:26-27; 13:14; Deut 6:20-21; Psalm 44:1-8; 71:18; 78:3-8*

NOTE In each of these passages, God makes it clear that the children of His people will no doubt be asking these questions. Now, imagine what would happen if they failed to teach their children WHY all these things were done and how great and glorious God had been in His-Story. What if the world taught them otherwise??

- **10**th day — The Bible says (4:19) the people came up out of Jordan on the TENTH day of the first month of the year. This is the EXACT day that the lambs were to be taken for the Passover as established by God for their exodus from Egypt. Exodus 12:2, 3; Mt 21:4-5; Mk 11:9-10; Lk 19:37-38; Jn 12:13-15

NOTE During our study of Mark, we learned that the "Triumphal Entry" of Jesus Christ during His first coming was on Sunday, the 11th day of Nisan. The day prior is when the people began to take their lambs and bring them for inspection. At the 2nd coming of Christ, Jesus will no doubt take the same route; the same day!

- ✓ God had a plan to provoke the next generation to ask questions that His Word can answer.
 - A memorial for ever God was intentional in creating opportunities to teach the children.

Psalm 145:4 "One generation shall praise thy works to another..."

Truth: Glorious _____ can abound if one generation faithfully teaches another.

Learning: If we do not teach God's answers, the devil will teach them his lies.

- \checkmark God wanted the next generation to experience the power and majesty of prior generations.
 - As the LORD did God wanted the children of His people to know history is His-Story!

Heb 13:8 "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever."

Truth: By connecting God's blessings to His past, we know God is the _____.

Learning: We must inspire another generation to believe God's promises.

- \checkmark The hope of future generations would be in the hands of faithful parents of God's people.
 - Train up a child God created a plan that would send the children to their fathers...

Psalm 78:4-7 "That they might **set their hope in God**, and not forget the works..."

Prov 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old..."

John 13:35 "By this shall all men KNOW that ye are my disciples, if ye have love..."

Truth: Children are an heritage of the LORD. Truth be taught caught!

Learning: Parents are accountable to walk with God; lead and teach the children.
