Today's Message: "Seeing Jesus"



INTRODUCTION

Last week, we were amazed at the precision of God's prophecies. The "Seventieth Week" of Daniel's prophecy is the most documented period in the Bible. Today, as we celebrate God's faithfulness and our 10th church anniversary, it seems fitting that Jesus Christ should be the **CENTER** of attention. Would you believe that is exactly what happens in Daniel 10! This is how good our God has been to us. As we have journeyed verse by verse through the Bible, God has always been in charge. Daniel got to SEE Jesus Christ. It sure will be worth it all when WE see Him! This is God's message to you...

LEARNING TOGETHER

A. The Text Daniel 10:1-21

#1. The Praying Prophet – as God revealed truth, Daniel PRAYED earnestly.

IN THOSE DAYS I DANIEL WAS MOURNING THREE FULL WEEKS

✓ In *the <u>third</u> year* of Cyrus king of Persia, Daniel saw another <u>VISION</u> from God.

- In 10:1, we find Daniel still in Persia and NOT in Jerusalem or his homeland.
- In *Ezra 1:1-4*, Cyrus made a proclamation for the Jews to go home!
 - o The *sum* of the returnees in *Ezra 2:64* was *42,360* + servants and maids.
 - The majority of priests, leaders, people preferred their Babylonian homes.
 - The adversaries of God troubled the rebuilding of the TEMPLE... 15 years!
- Daniel was GRIEVED and SERIOUS; he chose to FAST and PRAY for 3 full weeks!
 - In 9:3, we saw that Daniel set his face unto the Lord to PRAY and FAST.
 - In 10:12, the messenger said he chose to "CHASTEN thyself before thy God."
 - o In Lev 16:29-31, God said, "Ye shall afflict your souls" and rest as He said.
 - In **Psalm 69:10**, David said, "I wept, and chastened my soul with fasting."
 - In *Isaiah 58*, God called out those who were fasting for SELFISH MOTIVES.

What grieves you about the USA right now? The rejection of God and truth? What about the world that we live in and its spiraling decline into depravity? What about the state of God's Church? or millions of souls about to go to hell?

Ezra 1:1 Now in **the first year of** Cyrus king of Persia... the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus... that <u>he</u> made a proclamation...

Isaiah 58:9 Then shalt thou call, and

the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am.

Important Questions What is God leading YOU to do for Him?

#2. The Lord of Glory – Daniel got to SEE the pre-incarnate Lord Jesus Christ!



THEN I LIFTED UP MINE EYES, AND LOOKED... BEHOLD A CERTAIN MAN

- ✓ As Daniel was beside the great river (Tigris), he lifted up his eyes and saw Jesus!
 - In 10:4, Daniel was on the side of a river that flows primarily in IRAQ today!
 - o Operation Iraqi Freedom began March 20, 2003... the same geographic area.
 - In 10:5-6, he saw the <u>SAME</u> MAN that John saw in Revelation 1:12-18!

<u>Daniel 10:5-6</u>	Revelation 1:12-18
A certain man	One like unto the Son of man
CLOTHED in linen	CLOTHED with a garment down to the foot
Loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz	Girt about the paps with a golden girdle
His BODY also was like the beryl	NO direct comparison – what represents His body??
His FACE as the appearance of lightning	His HEAD and his HAIRS were white like wool
His EYES as lamps of fire	His EYES were as a flame of fire
His ARMS and his FEET like in colour to polished brass	His FEET like unto fine brass , as if they burned in a furnace
The VOICE of his words like the voice of a multitude	His VOICE as the sound of many waters

Isaiah 6::5

Then said I, **Woe is ME! for I am UNDONE**; because
I am a man of unclean lips...

Revelation 1:17
And when I saw him,
I fell at his feet AS DEAD.
And he laid his right hand
upon me, saying unto me,
Fear not; I am the first
and the last...

- In 10:7, he said he ALONE saw the vision... a great quaking fell on the others!
- In 10:8, he was left ALONE and saw this GREAT VISION...
 - There remained no strength in me... I retained no strength... (Repeated!)
 - o My comeliness was turned in me into corruption.
- In 10:9, he heard the VOICE OF HIS WORDS... he was face-first on the ground!
- In *Joshua 5:14*, Joshua SAW Jesus and *fell on his face to the earth* WORSHIP!
- In Acts 9:4-6, Saul SAW Jesus and fell to the earth astonished and TREMBLING!
- In Revelation 1:17, John, the beloved, saw Jesus and fell at His feet as DEAD!
 - What will it be like when YOU see Jesus Christ? Much different for saved and lost!

#3. The Spiritual Warfare – a messenger spoke of an <u>UNSEEN</u> spiritual battle.

BUT the PRINCE of the kingdom of Persia WITHSTOOD ME

Ephesians 6:12
For we WRESTLE
not against flesh
and blood...

Ezra 4:4

Then the people of the land weakened the hands of the people of Judah, and TROUBLED THEM IN BUILDING...

- ✓ A heavenly messenger was *hindered by spiritual warfare* in the UNSEEN WORLD.
 - In 10:10-21, Daniel was told behind earthly powers were evil spiritual POWERS.
 - o In *Col 1:16*, we learn Jesus Christ CREATED all things... ALL of these *beings*.
 - In Isa 14 and Ezek 28, we learn Satan is the ORIGIN of EVIL and their leader.
 - o In *Eph 6:12*, we learn that OUR ENEMY is NOT VISIBLE not flesh and blood.
- ✓ God dispatched His ANGELS to battle the UNSEEN ENEMY and protect His PEOPLE!
 - In 10:19-21, Daniel, the beloved, received strength by words of encouragement!
 - o In Ezra 4:1-5, we learn SATAN tried to STOP God's work and His WORSHIP!
 - In Rom 8:31-39, we learn God is FOR US and NOTHING can stop His work!

Romans 8:38-39

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
