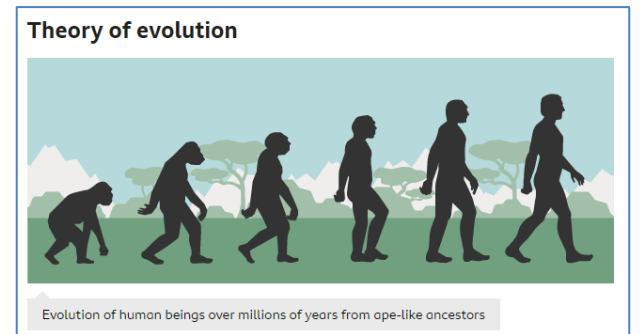
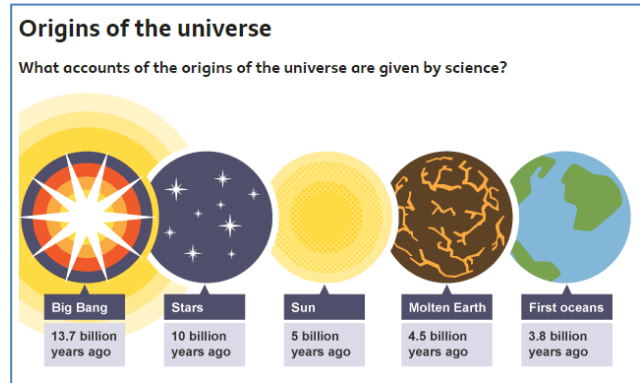
1. The Text Genesis 1:1 – In the beginning **God created** the heaven and the earth.

2. The Lesson The Bible begins with God *as the Creator*...

➤ **Genesis Lesson 2: *God is the supreme Creator.***

A. The Bible teaches that God is the Creator of _____ things. *Heb 11:1; Rom 1:20*

<i>God is the supreme Creator</i>	<i>The Bible teaches...</i>
In the beginning God created – Gen 1:1, 27	<i>The Creator created</i>
The LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth – Isa 40:28; 42:5	<i>The Creator is Supreme</i>
I create – Isa 45:7-18; 48:7, 16-17; 54:16; 57:19; 65:17, 18	<i>The Creator creates</i>
From the beginning of the creation God made them – Mk 10:6	<i>Jesus spoke of God as Creator</i>
Go... and preach the gospel to every creature – Mk 16:15	<i>Jesus died for God’s creation</i>
For by him were all things created – Col 1:23	<i>Jesus Christ is the Creator</i>
Thou art worthy, O LORD, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created. – Rev 4:11; 5:13	<i>Heaven glorifies God and Jesus Christ as the supreme Creator</i>
O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker. – Psalm 95:6	<i>Our Creator deserves our worship and obedience</i>

B. The Bible teaches that man does not want a Creator and wants to be his _____ god.

<i>Man does not want a Creator.</i>	<i>The Bible teaches...</i>
But none saith, Where is God my maker – Job 35:10-12	<i>Man is full of sin and pride</i>
He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker – Prov 14:31	<i>Man reproaches his Creator</i>
And forgettest the LORD thy Maker – Isa 51:13; Hos 8:14	<i>Man forgets his Creator</i>
Invisible things of him from the creation... clearly seen – Rom 1:20	<i>Man is without excuse: Creator</i>
Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator – Rom 1:21-32	<i>Man changes the truth of God into a lie; believes his own lie.</i>

C. The root cause issue related to our Creator is one of **authority**. *Phil 2:9-11*

Remember now <u>thy</u> Creator in the days of <u>thy</u> youth – Ecc 12:1	<i>There is a battle for <u>your</u> worship</i>
Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, <u>the beginning of the creation of God</u> – Rev 3:14	<i>Laodiceans need reminded of the beginning of the creation of God!</i>
