Acts 28:1-10 God's Perfect Timing – Trusting God at all times

Context: Paul is three months at Melita (Malta) with Barbarians

- 1. The barbarous people showed great kindness to the survivors.
 - ✓ Once on the shore of the island Melita, they were greeted by Barbarians.
 - √ The Barbarians showed them no little kindness because of the rain and cold.
- 2. The barbarous people had an established form of superstitious religion.
 - ✓ The Barbarians were on a remote island cutoff from main-stream civilization.
 - ✓ What the Barbarians believed:
 - Their belief system where they defined right and wrong.
 - They believed Paul was a murderer because of what happened to him.
 - They believed in a providential judgment process called "vengeance."
 - They believed evildoers would be rewarded for their evil deeds.
 - They believed a lack of an evil result meant that Paul was a god.
 - ✓ The Barbarians easily changed their minds on what they believed to be true.
- 3. As a result of the shipwreck, Paul was able to heal the father of Publius.
 - ✓ Paul used his apostolic gift available to him for that time in history.
 - ✓ By God's providence...
 - Paul was on the island at the right place to save the man.
 - Paul was on the island at the right <u>time</u> to save the man.
- 4. Others, which had diseases and came, were healed and were used by God to provide for the needs of Paul and the others headed for Rome.
 - ✓ God allowed Paul to heal many others while his thorn in the flesh remained.
 - ✓ In the end, God used the Barbarians to provide for the needs of Paul <u>and</u> others.
