### **E** – The Biblical Responsibilities of a Wife

1. She is to **SUBMIT** to her husband – *Eph 5:22; Col 3:18; 1 Pet 3:1,6; Tit 2:5* 

The husband was given by God to serve in the role of headship, the women is commissioned by God to submit – this breaks down into 4 basic ways:

**AS** unto the **LORD** – Eph 5:22

• The type of submission that evidences that she belongs to Jesus Christ!

**AS** the **CHURCH** does to Christ – *Eph 5:24* 

• The whole Bible is the instruction manual for this

AS it is FIT in the Lord - Col 3:18

Not in anything that would NOT be fitting to the Lord (beating, abuse, sexual, etc.)

**AS SARAH** – 1 Pet 3:1, 6

- Although she makes mistakes, she did understand that Abraham was her leader
- 2. She is to **LOVE** her husband *Titus 2:4* 
  - To know exactly what her husband needs and wants
  - To love him how he is made (5 love languages Gary Chapman)
  - To where you know so how to love him that you are able to "teach" younger women to do the same
    - o He is your best friend and others would say the same
    - Prav for him
    - Support him
    - Never, never, never speak critically about him to others!
    - Prepare and keep yourself for him (and kids)
- 3. She to **REVERANCE** her husband *Eph 5:33* 
  - 13 times in the Bible Lev 19:30; 26:2; 2 Sam 9:6; 1 King 1:31; Esther 3:2,5; Ps 89:7; Mt 21:37; Mk 12:6; Lk 20:13; Heb 12:9, 28
  - Treat your husband like you would treat Christ
  - Your attitude and your actions should demonstrate respect for him!
- 4. She is to **HELP** her husband Gen 2:18
  - See your husband as the head
  - The Lord is working THROUGH him (authority structure) to accomplish something
  - KNOW WHAT IT IS!!!
  - Do not assume it!!!
  - Do what you should **to help him**! -- Col 3:18
  - EXAMPLE testimony of missionary from KCBT
    - When God called him to the field...
    - When God called his wife to the field the same field she had photographs of that day!!

Ephesians 5:22, 24 - "as"

**Submission – vs 22** How do you submit to Christ?

**Subjection – vs 24** How are you subject unto Christ?

**Examples of the Apostle Paul: Paul is a member of the Church...** 

He was not **ASHAMED** of Christ, but was His ambassador – Rpm 1:16-17

• Do not be ashamed of your husband; you represent him and your family!

He was **PERSECUTED** by his own people, the Jews – Acts 9:23-24

• 20<sup>th</sup> century women of this world will not like you obeying God on these issues!

He was cast into **PRISON** and the jailer was converted – Acts 16:16-34

He took a problem situation and turned it into an opportunity!

He rightly used ALL means necessary to accomplish the mission – Acts 16:35-39

Practically, with household good, etc.

He did things he did not have to, out of love for people & God – Acts 18:1,3;1 Cor 4:12;9:1-27

■ We work together – Mel and I – Paul loved God – God loves people
