WEEK 1. INSPIRATION AND PRESERVATION

Consider this...

God **spoke**...and then men **wrote**...and then He **preserved** it in a Book.

BIBLE STUDY KEYS FOR TODAY

- God has a <u>BOOK</u>.
- God wanted men to have a <u>BOOK</u> to remember Him and what He has done.
- God spoke and men wrote down what He <u>SAID</u> with the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- God promised to preserve His <u>WORDS</u> His book.
- God cannot <u>LIE</u>. Titus 1:2; Hebrews 6:18
- That means that on the planet right now there must be a book from God that contains <u>EXACTLY</u> what God said. 2 Kings 22:8; 2 Chronicles 34:15
- If such a book existed (and it does), it would have to be the final <u>AUTHORITY</u> on all matters – it would be authorized by the King of kings.

Ecclesiastes 8:4	Where the word of a king is , there is power : and who may say unto him, What doest thou?
Matthew 7:29	For he taught them as one having authority , and not as the scribes.
1 Timothy 6:15	Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings , and Lord of lords;
