
REVIEW

WEEK 7. The History of the English Bible

There were _____ key English translations leading up to the book that launched the greatest period in church history – the Philadelphian Church Period. (There were others...these were the key translations)

- 1) The Wycliffe Bible (1382)
- 2) The Tyndale Bible (1525)
- 3) The Coverdale Bible (1535)
- 4) The Matthew Bible (1537)
- 5) The Great Bible (1539)
- 6) The Geneva Bible (1560)
- 7) The Bishops' Bible (1568)

NOTE Before we get to the 8th (after a seven-fold purification process)...we need to remember that Satan is watching this unfold as well...

Satan's counter attack - Three known attempts to prohibit the next version...

- 1) Pope Sixtus V, King Philip of Spain and the Spanish Armada (May 29, 1588) -
 - NOTE Spain attempts to overthrow England. They should have been able to since strongest navy...however...as they made their way across the English Channel... God took over...a storm perked up and wiped them all out...look at the date!!! (they lose 79 ships and over 17,000 men)
- 2) The assassination attempt of King James I (October 26, 1605) -
 - NOTE The "Gunpowder Plot"...the opening session of parliament was about to take place...an anonymous warning is issued...5 assassins (RC) are found in the basement with gunpowder. It was a failed assassination attempt intended to kill King James...look at the date!!!
- 3) The Roman Catholic Douay Rheims Bible (1610) -
 - NOTE
 It was translated from Jerome's corrupt Latin Vulgate (translated from the *Alexandrian* aka Origen bible). Remember Satan's MO if you can't beat them, join them! Is it the 8th English Bible...no way...it is corrupt!!! Which, by the way, was not written so RC's could have an English bible...?

The King James Version of 1611 (also called the Authorized Version)

Here are the events leading up to its arrival...

Queen Elizabeth DIES in 1603...

She never married, thus there was no direct heir to the throne of England.

Her nephew, James VI of Scotland was proclaimed James I, King of England.

On his way to the throne he is approached by a delegation of pastors with a list of grievances against the Church of England. It had been signed by 1000 Puritan ministers, thus becoming known as the "Millenary Petition."

King James said that the grievances would be addressed at a conference to be held on January 14-18, 1604 at Hampton Court.

Invited to the conference were 4 Puritans, 9 Bishops, 9 Clergymen, and 4 professors from Cambridge and Oxford.

At the conference, John Reynolds (A Puritan) would make a request of the king that would now translated, such versions as are extant not answering to the original."

James recognized that England needed a translation that would the country behind a **single English Bible**.

The Great Bible was too cumbersome...the Geneva Bible was too controversial...the Bishop's Bible was too careless...

On **July 22, 1604**, King James placed his official authorization on the proposal... "That a franslation be made of the whole Bible, as consonant as can be to the original Hebrew and Greek; and this to be set out and printed, without any marginal notes, and only to be used in all churches of England, in time of Divine service."

On that same date, King James announced he had selected **54** men to translate the new Bible.

The qualification required of each man was that he be a **proven** scholar...and wow were they!

The meticulous work began in 1607...and what a meticulous work it was! (another time®)

Key Point:	England was now destined to become the greatest, most powerful NATION in the world. Its conquests would carry them to every continent. They would have an English Bible that would accompany them.

Matthew 5:22

<u>KJV</u>

But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother **without a cause** shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

NKJV

"But I say to you that whoever is **angry with his brother** without a cause* shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, 'You fool!' **shall be in danger of hell fire**.

NIV

But I tell you that anyone who is **angry with his brother*** will be subject to **judgment**. Again, anyone who says to his brother, 'Raca,*' is answerable to the Sanhedrin. But anyone who says, 'You fool!' will be **in danger of the fire of hell**.

"But I say to you that everyone who is **angry with his brother** shall be *guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, '*You good-for-nothing,' shall be *guilty before *the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be *guilty enough to go into the *fiery hell.

RSV

But I say to you that every one who is **angry with his brother** shall be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother shall be liable to the council, and whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be liable to the hell of fire.

KEY There is a very significant subtlety that is found in the newer versions. Matthew 5:22 clearly states that if someone is angry with his brother *without a cause* then he will be in danger of judgment and hell fire.

Now, consider this passage of Scripture where Jesus was angry with a cause...for God's glory!.

Luke 19:45 – And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought; Luke 19:46 – Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
