

Acts 26 *Almost a Christian – Life's Greatest Decision*

NOTES

Acts 26:1-32 Paul stands before Agrippa

1. Paul began with his manner of life **BEFORE** he met the Lord Jesus Christ.
2. When Paul's eyes were opened to see his crimes against the Lord Jesus Christ, he made a **DECISION** to obey the Lord and to turn from darkness to light.
3. Paul said God gave him a **PURPOSE** for living – life's greatest calling.
4. Paul said he was **NOT DISOBEDIENT** unto the heavenly vision.
5. Festus used a **LOUD VOICE** to interrupt Paul (and the Gospel) and to mock him.
6. Paul said he was not mad but spoke forth the words of truth and **SOBERNESS**.
7. Paul was first fully persuaded **HIMSELF** of the truth that he spoke to others.
8. Paul **THEN** persuaded King Agrippa to be a Christian.
9. King Agrippa was **ALMOST** persuaded to be a Christian.
10. By not believing and receiving Jesus Christ, King Agrippa fully **REJECTED** Jesus Christ!
