

#7 THE CREATION FACTOR

1. The invisible things of God are understood by the _____ which He has made.

- Psalm 19:1; 97:6 The Bible clearly says the _____ declare _____ righteousness.

NOTE: Practically speaking, He is the Creator – the very existence of life/creation is evidence of a creator or intelligent design.

- Romans 1:14-20 The invisible things of God are understood by the creation He has made.

NOTE: Look again at verse 20 – we see 3 things:

1. We understand the invisible things of God by the physical, visible things that are made (creation).
2. His eternal power
3. The Godhead (trinity) – Father, Son, Holy Spirit

a. No one has an excuse because of:

1. _____ revelation It is general because it is observable by everyone

2. _____ revelation The Bible – God is faithful to always send a missionary

NOTE: The lost multitudes in the middle of nowhere are included in this category...

b. God had a pattern when He created everything...the pattern was _____.

The Godhead = the trinity = 3

NOTE: He is the pattern!

c. Not only is God triune, His overall attributes are also revealed in three ways:

1. OMNI _____ – all powerful

2. OMNI _____ – all knowing

3. OMNI _____ – always present everywhere
