"The Humility of Jesus Christ"



INTRODUCTION

Last week, we were exhorted to live for Jesus Christ. He ought to be our life! Amen. And we are to be truly set apart for Jesus Christ – for His magnification and service daily. Paul was not concerned with whether he lived or died because either way he would **GLORIFY** Christ! Today, we have arrived at one of the greatest passages in the Bible. Few doctrinal truths surpass the **HUMILITY** of Jesus Christ. However, the context of the passage may surprise you. Sometimes, we are so focused on the theology of this chapter that we forget the lesson that is being taught to us. This is God's message to you...

- ❖ The Text Philippians 2:1-11
 - A. The Context the Holy Spirit's focus is on unity for the Gospel's sake.
 - 1. Paul begins with an appeal to what they have **EXPERIENCED** in Christ.

Important Note

The context of chapter 2 is the end of chapter 1 ... a focus on the unity of the believers for Christ and the Gospel's sake.

John 14:18, 27

I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. 27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you...

- **Philippians 2:1** If there be THEREFORE any...
- Philippians 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ...
 - ... that ye stand fast in ONE SPIRIT,
 - ... with ONE MIND striving together for the faith of the gospel;
- Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to keep THE UNITY OF THE SPIRIT in the bond of peace.

Blessings found in Christ:

Consolation in Christ Comfort; alleviation of distress of mind; hope, joy, courage

Comfort of Love To strengthen; to cheer or enliven; to relieve or help

• Fellowship of the Spirit Companionship; consort; familiar communications and care

Bowels and Mercies The seat of emotions; pity or kindness; compassion

B. The Charge – believers must esteem others above themselves.

- 2. Paul exhorts the believers to be likeminded and **UNIFIED** in Christ.
 - Philippians 2:2 Fulfill ye my joy, that ye be LIKEMINDED, having THE SAME LOVE, being of ONE ACCORD, of ONE MIND.

"Fulfill ye my joy..."

The Apostle Paul was exhorting the believers he loved dearly and prayed for often to not allow small disagreements and disunity to become a hinderance to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Question

How much unity would there be if

believers cared

more about OTHERS than themselves?

W1828 "vainglory"

Exclusive vanity

excited by one's own performances;

empty pride; undue

elation of mind.

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3. Paul continues his exhortation as to **HOW** to be accomplish this unity.

Philippians 2:3 – Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory;

- Philippians 2:4 Look not every man on his own things,
- but every man also on the things of OTHERS.

Opposing Character Qualities:

Strife or vainglory Contention for superiority; struggle for victory (James 3,4) Lowliness of mind

but in lowliness of mind let each esteem OTHER betther than themselves.

Freedom from pride; humility; humbleness of mind

Esteem other better To set a higher value on; to put their needs before your own

Others Not you! Stop thinking about yourself...

C. The Christ – the most glorious example of Paul's teaching – Jesus Christ!

- 4. Paul appeals to the greatest example of **HUMILITY** every known to man!
 - **Philippians 2:5** LET THIS MIND **be in you**, which was also in Christ Jesus:
