INTRODUCTION

Last week, we began one of the most important books of the Bible! We learned of the beloved disciple John and how his gospel account portraying Jesus Christ as God contains the very important records about His life and ministry. Today, we will see how God wastes no time getting into the most important details! The first words of John are some of the most powerful words ever spoken or written. The pre-existence of Jesus Christ and His undeniable <u>**DEITY**</u> are the focus today. As we believe, the doctrine of Jesus Christ is central to our <u>**FAITH**</u> and a heaven and hell issue. A. The Text John 1:1-2

#1. The Eternal God – the genealogy of Jesus Christ begins just like <u>GENESIS</u>.

IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD... THE SAME WAS IN THE BEGINNING

✓ Jesus Christ pre-dates time; He is the Alpha and Omega, the FIRST and the LAST!

- In Genesis 1:1, God was... "In the beginning God..."
- In Exodus 3:14, God said, "I AM THAT I AM...."
- In Isaiah 9:6, Jesus is called, "The Everlasting Father."
- In John 8:58, Jesus said, "Before Abraham was, I am."
- In Colossians 1:17, "And he is before all things..."
- In Isaiah 41:4, 44:6, and 48:12, God said, "I am THE FIRST, and I am THE LAST..."
- In Rev 1:11, 17, 2:8, and 22:13, Jesus said, "I am...THE FIRST and THE LAST..."

Revelation 1:11 Saying, I AM Alpha and Omega, THE FIRST and THE LAST...

NOTE Jesus Christ is the eternal God, the great I AM, the one who was **BEFORE** all things. He is **not** a created being; He always was and always will be, God!

#2. The Godhead – there is <u>no</u> doubt Jesus Christ and God are the <u>SAME</u>.

AND THE WORD **WAS <u>WITH</u> GOD**, AND THE WORD <u>**WAS GOD**</u>.... <u>**WITH GOD**</u>

Genesis 22:8

And Abraham said,

My son, God will

provide himself a lamb

for a burnt offering...

- ✓ In **1 John 5:7**, God says, "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one."
 - The doctrine of Christ is founded on the truth that He is God. In the account of Abraham and Isaac in Genesis 22:8, it says, "God will provide HIMSELF a lamb..."
- ✓ There are 3 key Hebrew names ascribed to God in the Old Testament:
 - 1. **Jehovah** God's most common name. It occurs 6519 times in 5521 verses. It is the name of the Supreme God amongst the Hebrews.
 - 2. **Elohim** Refers to God's power and might. He is the Creator and Sustainer of all things. It is unique in that it is a plural reference to God. It occurs 2606 times in 2249 verses.
 - 3. **Adonai** Refers to God as Master and Owner. He is the Ruler over all things. It occurs 434 times in 419 verses.
- ✓ The KJV key to the names of God in the Old Testament (reserved ONLY for the one true God!)

- ✓ Jesus Himself clearly **CLAIMED** to be Jehovah God. **Revelation 1:8; John 8:12-59; 10:22-33**
- ✓ Jesus willingly received **WORSHIP** as Jehovah God. *Ex 34:14; Lk 2:15; Mt 2:2; <u>Jn 20:28</u>*

Godly men and angels refused to receive worship for themselves. (Acts 10:25-26; 14:6-15; Rev 19:10; 22:8-9), yet JESUS WILLINGLY RECEIVED WORSHIP: by angels (Heb 1:6), by shepherds (Lk 2:15), by the wise men (Mt 2:2, 11), by a leper (Mt 8:2), by a ruler (Mt 9:18), by a woman (Mt 15:25), by the maniac (Mk 5:6), by the man born blind (Jn 9:38), by Thomas (Jn 20:28), by some Greeks (Jn 12:20-21), by His disciples (Mt 14:33; 28:9), and by the saints (Rev 5:11-14).

Conclusion: An honest, reasonable person <u>must</u> conclude ... JESUS IS UNDENIABLY <u>GOD</u>!
