c. Regeneration, Justification, Adoption, and Sanctification			
	 In <i>Justification</i>, your is changed. <i>Rom 3:28; 5:1</i> The sinner is declared RIGHTEOUS. 		
	 In <i>Regeneration</i>, your is changed. 2Cor 5:17; Gal 6:15 The born-again Christian becomes a child of God and is a NEW CREATURE in Christ. 		
	 In Adoption, your is changed. Jn 3:6; Gal 3:26;4:5,7; Rom 8:15 The born-again Christian is taken from the world system under the Devil and placed in Jesus Christ as one of God's SONS. 		
 In Sanctification, your is changed. It is the fruit of a justified life. It is separation FROM evil and UNTO God. There are three on Sanctification: PAST – the moment you trusted Christ. 1 Cor 6:11 We received Christ's righteousness. Heb 10:14 PRESENT – your day-by-day sanctification. Jn 17:17; 1Ths 4:3 We have fruit unto holiness. Rom 6:22 FUTURE – someday you will be perfect like Christ. 1Jo 3:2 			
	 We <i>will be</i> conformed to the image of Christ. NOTE This is LIKE the three TENSES of <i>Salvation</i>. 1. PAST – you <i>were saved</i> from the <i>penalty</i> of sin – HELL. 2. PRESENT – you <i>are being saved</i> from the <i>power</i> of sin. 3. FUTURE – you <i>will be saved</i> from the <i>presence</i> of sin.
