# INTRODUCTION

Today, we introduce our new book and learn of the life and faithfulness of Paul's disciple Timothy. As we will discover, there is much we can glean from the Bible on the life of Timothy. His spiritual story began as a **CHILD** with the holy Scriptures being read and taught to him by his mother and grandmother. As a young man, he got saved under the missionary endeavors of Paul on the 1<sup>st</sup> Missionary Journey. It would be early in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Missionary Journey that Paul would find young Timothy **READY** and willing to join God's missionary team. Timothy is a **MODEL** disciple. And he was faithful to Jesus Christ unto his death as a faithful martyr in Ephesus. May we commit ourselves to God and follow his example!

### A. Overview of 1 Timothy \* FUNDAMENTAL INFORMATION \*

Title Means: Worshipper of God; Honoring of God

The Numbers:Chapters: 6 | Verses: 113 | Words: 2,269 Ps 12:6-7; Prov 30:5Author:PAUL\*Paul writes in the 1st person throughout the entire letter to his disciple.


*Historical Time*: 63 AD to 65 AD (This is likely after 1<sup>st</sup> imprisonment in Rome and before the 2<sup>nd</sup>)

Theme: How to Conduct Yourself in the Church (a local NT Church) of the Living God!

Keynote:Timothy is the ideal disciple. He was likely led to Christ, discipled, and trained by Paul<br/>himself. This letter is an admonition to a young man in whom Paul had invested his life.<br/>Together, they typify the proper relationship between a disciple-maker and a disciple.

#### THREE BASIC APPLICATIONS

- 1. Historical Paul writes to Timothy, a young pastor, to detail the order and <u>CONDUCT</u> of his local New Testament church.
- **2. Doctrinal** God teaches us, by clear scriptural revelation, the importance of and <u>ORDER</u> of our local churches (today and throughout church history).
- **3. Devotional** God clearly instructs us on the kind of people we should be as <u>MEMBERS</u> of a local church to ensure the success of our ministry.

### B. The Lesson Acts 16:1-3; 1 Timothy 1:1-2

# > A Certain Disciple – God had prepared a young man to do His WORK.

- 1. His **PARENTS**. The son of a CERTAIN woman, which was a JEWESS, and BELIEVED...
  - **2Tim 1:5** ...which dwelt FIRST in <u>thy grandmother Lois</u>, and <u>thy mother Eunice</u>...
- 2. His <u>CHILDHOOD</u>. From a CHILD thou hast KNOWN the holy scriptures... 2Tim 3:15
  - Proverbs 22:6 Train up a CHILD in the WAY <u>he should go</u>...
- 3. The holy <u>SCRIPTURES</u>. Which are ABLE to make thee wise UNTO salvation... 2Tim 3:15
  - **Psalm 119:105** Thy WORD is a LAMP unto my feet, and a LIGHT unto my path.
- 4. His <u>SALVATION</u>. MY own SON in the faith... MY dearly beloved SON... 1Tim 1:2; 2Tim1:2
- 5. His **<u>TESTIMONY</u>**. Which was WELL REPORTED OF by the BRETHREN... Acts 14; 16:2-3

NOTE It is evident that Timothy was PREPARED and READY to do the WORK of the Lord!

# > A Model Disciple – Timothy was faithful to accomplish God's PLAN for His life!

- 1. He was a DISCIPLE and PASTOR. 1 Tim 1:2-3; 3:1
- 2. He was <u>WILLING</u>. Him would Paul have to go forth with him... Acts 16:1-3
- **3.** He was **BRAVE**. But Silas and Timotheus abode there still ... Acts 17:14
- 4. He was <u>OBEDIENT</u>. Timotheus for to come... they departed... Acts 17:15; 19:22
- 5. He was MINISTERING. Acts 19:22; 20:4; Philippians 2:19
- 6. He was HARD working. Timotheus, MY WORKFELLOW... Romans 16:21; 1Cor 16:10
- 7. He was **FAITHFUL**. And FAITHFUL IN THE LORD... 1Corinthians 4:17
- 8. He was LIKE-MINDED. For I have NO MAN LIKEMINDED... Philippians 2:19-24
- 9. He was OBSERVANT. Timotheus... BROUGHT us good tidings... 1Thessalonians 3:5-6
- 10. He was CO-LABOURING. Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus... 2Thessalonians 1:1
- **11.** He was **<u>BELOVED</u>**. To Timothy, my DEARLY BELOVED son... **2Timothy 1:2**

# 12. His ministry was ENDURING. Timothy is set at liberty... Acts 16:1 to Hebrews 13:23

**NOTE** In the end, Timothy died a MARTYR for our Lord Jesus Christ! What a life story!
