"300 Men"

INTRODUCTION



Last week, we began the 4th of 7 cycles of sin found in Judges. The children of Israel did evil again in God's sight and were overrun by the Midianites. After seven years, they cried out to God, and He came down to raise up Gideon. After some tough questions for God and proving Him, Gideon threw down his father's altar to Baal, cut down the groves and worshipped God! Today, we will once again listen to God as He **SPEAKS** to Gideon. He will tell Gideon that he has too many soldiers! God will try the men and choose **300** men for His military strategy. The ensuing events and victory have become some of the most beloved stories in the holy Bible. For God will use a **DREAM** and some campfire stories to bring down the Midianites who were like grasshoppers for multitude. The 300 will blow their trumpets, break their pitchers, hold their lamps and yell, *"The sword of the LORD and of Gideon!"* What a story!

LEARNING TOGETHER

A. The Text Judges 7:1-25

- #1. The Rebellion the children of Israel did evil again in God's sight. (6:1)
- #2. The Retribution Israel was greatly impoverished by the Midianites. (6:2-6)
- #3. The Restoration God personally sought a man to <u>DELIVER</u> Israel. (6:7-7:25)



Review: The children of Israel cried unto the Lord... the LORD 1st sent a prophet... **Review**: Then the Angel of the LORD came and sat... appeared unto Gideon... **Review**: The LORD gave Gideon an opportunity to take a faith step that night...

➢ Gideon and all the people with him pitched beside the well of Harod ...
 ✓ God calls Gideon the name his father gave... "Jerubbaal" – Jdg 6:32; 1 Sam 12:11
 ✓ The Midianites were north in "Valley of Jezreel" – Jdg6:33; 1Ki 21:23; Hos 1:5,11

- God said, "The people that are with thee are too MANY" ...
 - ✓ God knows that Israel would *vaunt themselves against Him*. *Deut8:17; Zec12:7*
 - ✓ The Numbers: The host of the Midianites totaled ... <u>135,000</u> men! Jdg 8:10
 - ✓ The Numbers: Assembled army of Gideon totaled ... <u>32,000</u> men! Jdg 7:3

NOTE God is intentionally going to REDUCE the "odds" (4:1) for His glory! Zech 4:6

		 God said, "Whosoever is fearful and afraid, let him return" ✓ Mount Gilead is east of Jordan River – where Jacob fled from Laban! Gen 31:21 ✓ The Numbers: 22,000 men QUIT and returned! Remaining 10,000 men!
	NOTE	At this point, God has reduced Gideon's earthly disadvantage which is now 14 to 1 !
		 God said, "The people are yet too many" ✓ God said He would try the men – bring to WATER! Pr 17:3; Isa 48:10; Jer 17:10 ✓ 300 lapped like a dog; 9,700 bowed down upon knees to the water FACE first! ✓ God picks the men who didn't lose their head; tells everyone else to go home!
	NOTE	God finally has Gideon and the team where He needs them; size is now 450 to 1!
God warns in drean Gen 20:3 – Abimele Gen 31:24 – Labar Gen 41:25 – Pharac Dan 2:3 – king of Bab	ns <u>:</u> ch n	 God said, "Arise, get thee down unto the host But if thou fear to go down" ✓ God gave 2 options - Option A = Go now; Option B = Take Phurah, and LISTEN! ✓ Gideon chose the second option (of course) and went down with Phurah. ✓ Upon arrival, behold, a man is telling his DREAM! *87 times in KJV; Num 12:6 ✓ His fellow then boldly interprets the dream as the SWORD of Gideon! Jdg 6:15 ✓ Gideon's response to both - he WORSHIPPED God! Gen24:26; Ex12:27; Neh8:6
	NOTE	Gideon is so confident now, he returns and tells the men, ARISE, the LORD has this!
Every man's hand <u>:</u> 1 – TRUMPET Sound out God's judgment (1Thess 1:8 2 – PITCHER Earthen vessel to be broken (2 Cor 4:7) 3 – LAMP To shine light (Mt 5:10)	3)	 And he divided the three hundred men into three companies ✓ Gideon equipped the men with 3 things: a <u>TRUMPET</u>, a <u>PITCHER</u>, and a <u>LAMP</u>. ✓ They did as Gideon said and cried, <i>"The sword of the LORD and of Gideon!"</i> ✓ The enemies response: <i>"And all the host ran, and cried, and fled."</i> ✓ The LORD set every man's sword against his fellow – all the host – and fled! ✓ Men of Israel gathered themselves together – Naphtali, Asher, all Manasseh! ✓ Gideon sent for help from Ephraim – they slew them; brought 2 prince heads!
	NOTE	God wrought a great victory with 300 men willing to trust, obey, go, stand for Him!
#4.		Rest – God had a plan to use Gideon to bring rest to His people. God will ultimately bring rest to Israel for 40 years in the days of Gideon. Jdg 8:28

- (How can you apply this message to your life?) **B.** The Lessons
 - 1. God has chosen to use the **HUMBLE** and weak things of this world for His glory!

Question: Are you humble today? Weak in fleshly strength? 1 Cor 1:26-31; Zech 4:6 *

2. Sometimes God gives you MORE than you can handle so He alone gets all glory!

Question: Why not let go and let God today? Joel 3:10; Mt 11:28; 2Cor 12:10; 1Pet 5:7 •••
