# Section 4 – FAMILY

### A. The BASIC role of the Father

- 1. The Father is the "LEADER" of the home 1 Tim 3:4; Gal. 4:1-2
  - He is completely responsible for meeting the family's needs 1 Tim 5:8
- 2. The Father must lead by **EXAMPLE** 1 Tim 1:16; Titus 2:7
  - Not just devotion time
  - Do as I "do" not as I "say"???????
- 3. The Father must take *full* and complete **<u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>** for the home *Eph 5:23b* 
  - Identify each's weakness and help to strengthen 2 Cor 12:9-10; Rom 15:1
- 4. The Father must establish **DISCIPLINE** Pr. 13:24; 22:15; 23:13; 29:15
  - Proper discipline is an act of love be careful not to provoke *Eph 6:4*
  - Father sets the standards but is <u>NOT</u> the sole enforcer
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Mother must be included or it will create division in the home  $\,$

### **B.** The BASIC role of the Mother

- 1. The Mother is the "KEEPER" of the home Titus 2:5; 1 Ti. 5:14 (outside home?)
  - Father **MUST** submit to the mother's instructions concerning the keeping of the home *Eph 5:21* (obviously he can offer ideas/input, etc.
- 2. The Mother is to be a VIRTUOUS woman Proverbs 31:10-31
  - Every wife/mother must study and know the qualities of this woman!
  - Ruth only woman directly referred to as "virtuous" the church
- She is extremely **VALUABLE**; She is **TRUSTED**; She does that which is **GOOD**;
- She is a hard WORKER; She is a good COOK; She is a wise SHOPPER;
- She takes care of **EVERYONE** in the family; She is **HOSPITABLE**;
- She plans AHEAD; She saves MONEY;
- She is both **PHYSICALLY** and **MENTALLY** strong;
- She conducts the business of her home **PROFITABLY**; She is **CARING**;
- She is **<u>CLEAN</u>**; She **<u>DRESSES</u>** herself and her family good;
- She fulfills her responsibilities as a **WIFE**; She loves God and knows the **BIBLE**;
- She **<u>TEACHES</u>** others; She is **<u>BELOVED</u>**;
- She knows when to **<u>SPEAK</u>** and when to be quiet.

## C. The BASIC role of Children

- 1. A Child is to OBEY Ephesians 6:1-4; Col. 3:20
  - That about sums it all up!
- 2. Children learn to obey God by first learning to obey their **PARENTS**.
  - Children are object lessons for parents "the mirror"
  - We can go beyond Eph 6:1-4 and Col 3:20 when we understand that God is our **FATHER** and we are His children the entire Bible becomes our teacher...
