#### INTRODUCTION

Last week, we saw how much God cares about souls and how His church cares for them. This letter to Timothy is like a perfect, ministry *handbook* to guide us in such care. Today, we begin our approach towards the completion of this book. Over the course of the next 4 weeks, we will learn to be content, faithful, generous and trustworthy. Our passage today is focused on the first – *contentment*. Now think about God's <u>TIMING</u> of this truth considering what the world has been consumed with over the last few days! They are insane; we must be careful not to follow their madness. According to the word of God, *great grain* is not found in <u>MATERIAL</u> things or earthly stuff. Jesus Christ is <u>ENOUGH</u>!

## A. The Text 1 Timothy 6:1-10

# #1. Good Attitudes – servants and employees must WORK as to the Lord. (1-2) YOUR JOB AND EMPLOYER

#### **Your Vocation**

All saved people are called to "fulltime Christian service." Your vocation (job) is to serve Jesus Christ.

- ✓ This applies to all **EMPLOYEES**. Let as many servants as are under the yoke... **Eph 4:1**
- ✓ Your work **ATTITUDE** matters. Count... own masters worthy of all honor... **Eph 6:5-8**
- ✓ Your work can blaspheme. Name of God... his doctrine be not blasphemed. **2Cor 3:2**

#### **BELIEVING MASTERS**

- ✓ Believing employers should *not* be **DESPISED**. Let them not despise them... **Gal 6:10**
- ✓ They are family; do your **BEST** for them. *Brethren... do them service...* **1Cor 10:31**

**NOTE** The primary purpose of your job is to support your ministry – family, church, and reaching the lost. For most Christians, your fellow workers are the greatest (and sometimes the only) exposure you have to unsaved people.

# #2. Bad Teachers – unhealthy FRUIT comes from unhealthy people. (3-5)

#### WHOLESOME WORDS

- ✓ Wholesome words produce sound DOCTRINE. Wholesome... words of our Lord...
- √ Wholesome words produce GODLINESS. Which is according to godliness...

**W1828** "Wholesome" Sound words; healthy words.

#### IF ANY MAN TEACH OTHERWISE

#### **Consent Not**

Some people *reject* the word of God.
Some people *ignore* the word of God.
Some people *change* the word of God.

- ✓ They are **PROUD**. Consent NOT to wholesome WORDS... He is PROUD... **Job 41:34**
- ✓ They know **NOTHING**. *Knowing NOTHING*, but DOTING about QUESTIONS...
- ✓ They produce **EVIL** fruit. Strifes of WORDS... WHEREOF COMETH... **Mt 7:15-23** 
  - Envy mortification or discontent excited by sight of another's success
  - **Strife** exertion or contention for superiority; opposition; contrariety
  - Railings clamoring with insulting language; reproachful language
  - **Evil surmisings** the act of suspecting; imagining upon slight evidence
  - Perverse disputings the act of contending by words; controversy
- ✓ They are **DECEIVERS**. Supposing that GAIN IS GODLINESS...

**NOTE** Contrary to popular preaching ("Prosperity Theology"), gain is NOT godliness.

# #3. Great Gain – earthly wealth is <u>TEMPORARY</u>; Jesus Christ is eternal. (6-10)

#### THE LOVE OF MONEY

- ✓ They that WILL BE RICH *fall into*... (A **DESIRE** to be rich is very dangerous!)
  - **Temptation**... Gen 13:1-13; Num 22:17-19; Josh 7:11; 2Kings 5:20-27
  - A snare... Prov 1:19; 15:27; 20:21; 21:6; 22:16; 28:20-22; 2Pet 2:15,16; Jude 11
  - Many foolish and hurtful lusts... Isa 5:8; Amos 8:4-6; Zech 11:5; Jas 5:1-4
  - Which drown men in destruction and perdition. Mt 13:22; 19:22; 26:15
- ✓ For the LOVE of *money* is the ROOT of all evil... (It can **MOTIVATE** all forms of evil!)
  - Some coveted after... Ex 20:17; Jdg 17; 18; Rom 7:7; Col 3:5; 1John 2:15-17
  - Erred from the faith... Isa 1:23; 56:11; Acts 8:20; 2Tim 4:10; Titus 1:11
  - Pierced themselves through with many sorrows. Acts 1:16-20; 5:1-11

**NOTE** "For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world... lose his own soul?"

#### **GODLINESS WITH CONTENTMENT**

- ✓ A GREAT gain = godliness (eternal) WITH contentment (internal). Php 4:11-13
  - 1) At death, **NOTHING** goes with you. Carry nothing out. **Heb 9:27**
  - 2) Food and clothes are your basic **NEEDS**. And having food and raiment...
    - **Food** whatever is eaten for sustaining human life; victuals; provisions.
    - **Raiment** clothing in general; necessary garments for life and modesty.
- ✓ The **GREATEST** gain = Jesus Christ **WITH** contentment.
  - 1) Jesus Christ is ENOUGH. John 3:16, 36; 12:21; Eph 2:1-10; Col 1:27; Rev 1:18
  - 2) In Christ, we have ENOUGH. Mt 6:33; 2Cor 4:18; Php 3:20; Col 3:1-4; Heb 11:26

**NOTE** The old song goes, "Give me Jesus." Saints, He is all we need! Amen. Amen.
