INTRODUCTION



Last week, we continued with the third letter to Pergamos. Jesus Christ said Satan had a seat there of power and paganism (HQ). Paganism flooded "*Christianity*" as the church married the world. Today, we come to the church of Thyatira. Jesus Christ reminded them that He was the Son of God! Amen. With eyes like unto a <u>FLAME</u> of fire and feet like fine brass, He is a God of <u>JUDGMENT</u> and holiness. This industrious church was <u>SUFFERING</u> (tolerating) Jezebel to teach and seduce God's people to sin!

Seven Letters to Seven Churches

Historically – 7 real churches | Devotionally – all churches | Doctrinally – 7 periods of Church History

1. The Text Rev 2:18-29

- #1. The Church Thyatira "odor of affliction" Church History (500AD-1000AD)
 - **SUMMARY**: This is written to detail the scriptural heresy and physical human atrocities of Papal Rome; the term "*Dark Ages*" is most appropriate.
 - HISTORY: As we look back on church history, what happened during this time?
 - 1. Thyatira was well known for their dyes (purple/scarlet) and trade guilds.
 - ✓ Lydia in Philippi was a seller of purple dye from Thyatira. Acts 16:14-15
 - ✓ Each guild had their own pagan deity and rituals a dilemma for Christians?
 - 2. This period of time in history was accurately called the **DARK** Ages until now.
 - ✓ The Bible was removed from the hands of common people. **Ps 119:130**
 - ✓ *Roman religious councils completely replace the authority of God's word.*
 - ✓ The Roman church divided East (Constantinople, Byzantine) & West (Rome).
 - ✓ The Roman church was imprisoning, grilling, burning, beheading, impaling, torturing, killing **non-conformists** who <u>did not embrace their false doctrines</u>.
 - 3. A man named Mohammed (570-632AD) started Islam with visions, ANGEL visits.
 - ✓ He proclaimed himself a prophet and of the lineage of Ishmael. Gen 36
 - ✓ Muslims were heavily persecuted; perpetuated a hatred for "Christianity"

NOTE Thyatira comes from two words, one meaning "sacrifice" ... the other "continual."

#2. The <u>Commendation</u> – they were known for much <u>ACTIVITY</u> for God! (19)

- 1. It was a *faithful* church ... "works" "charity" "service" "faith" "patience"
 - ✓ This church was not rebuked for their work and charity for God! 1 Cor 13; 15:58
- 2. It was a hard-working church ... "thy works; and the last to be more than the first"
 - ✓ Their works got better as they persecution got more intense. Yours should also!

3. It did <u>not</u> tolerate the depths of Satan... "as many as have not <u>this doctrine</u>"

- ✓ There was a remnant of believers who opposed Jezebel's false doctrine (religion).
- ✓ When God's judgment fell upon Europe, He supernaturally protected them!

NOTE Bible believers were faithful in spite of their very limited access to God's words!

#3. The <u>Condemnation – many TOLERATED</u> false doctrines and evil sin! (20-23)

- 1. The doctrine of Jezebel to <u>teach</u> and <u>seduce</u> to commit spiritual fornication!
 - ✓ The tribe of Dan stole Micah's "religion" that was from Babylon. Jdg 17-18
 - ✓ The religion had black-robed priests called "fathers" who used idols in worship.
 - ✓ 500 years later, king Ahab married Jezebel (daughter of king of Zidonians).
 - ✓ He then served Baal; Jezebel led the pagan religion/priests. 1 Ki 16:30; 18:17
 - ✓ Jezebel used lies, false letters, lewd men, and murder to confiscate property.
 - ✓ Jezebel's religion is called <u>Baalism</u> in the OT and it is <u>Roman Catholicism</u> in NT.
- 2. The Black Death the historical consequences of Jezebel can be seen in history.
 - ✓ The 14th century yielded some of the most horrific records of the "BLACK DEATH."
 - The disease known as the "Bubonic Plague" began in 541AD along the commercial trade routes of the Roman Empire. Historian Procopius wrote that in the spring of 542AD, the plague arrived in Constantinople! By the end of the Dark Ages, some 25 million people would lay dead as a result (some estimate 50 million). Was this God's judgment? Rev 2:23 says God gave them space to repent; they refused His mercy!

NOTE Motto: "All the world must be Catholic." Most mistakenly believed it the true church.

- **2. The Lesson** (How can we learn from our passage today?)
 - **1.** You must <u>not</u> <u>TOLERATE</u> sin in your life and teaching against God's words.
 - > Ephesus was all truth and cold on love; Thyatira seemed to be all love and no truth!

Question: "What sin are you tolerating today?" Prov 5:21; 15:3; 1 Cor 5:6; Gal 5:9

- 2. In spite of opposition and adversaries, God commands you to **DO** His work.
 - These believers won multitudes to Christ, discipled them to carry on God's heritage!

Question: "Where is your faith? Are you doing the Lord's work?" 2 Tim 2:2; Mt 28!
