## **INTRODUCTION**

Before we begin our new journey through the book of Judges, we need to take a few weeks to consider what is going on in our world right now. We know God's church is the way that He has chosen to rescue souls from perishing. It is evident that perilous times have come! God's words are being trampled in the streets, and smooth-talking fools are driving God's church to retreat and We need help from God, and today we are going to get it from two key passages in the Scriptures. First, when Paul was testifying before king Agrippa, he was accused by Festus of being! Can you imagine? Can you relate? Second, in Paul's 1 <sup>st</sup> letter to Timothy, he exhorted him to avoid oppositions of falsely so called – it was science, but the adversaries were it science. That sure sounds familiar!

#1. The Pattern – Paul was called a man for preaching God's truth.
<ul> <li>➤ Paul was granted an open door by God, and he was to speak the truth!</li> <li>✓ He was on his way to Rome and preaching every opportunity given him. Acts 26</li> <li>■ He was happy to give an answer to lost people for Christ's sake. 26:1-2; 1 Pet 3:15</li> <li>■ He was excited to share his personal testimony before a lost world. 26:12-16</li> <li>■ He was preaching repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ alone. 26:17-21</li> <li>■ He was preaching the resurrection of Christ and the Hope of Israel. 26:22-23</li> </ul>
Festus interrupted with a loud voice and called Paul a mad, man!

**W1828:** "*mad*"

Disordered in intellect

- Paul did not allow an ignorant, loud, rude, profane man to distinguish the truth.

  Festus said, "Paul, thou art beside thyself; much learning doth make thee MAD."
- Paul said, "I am NOT MAD, most noble Festus." 1 Sam 21:13; Lk 8:26-35; 1Pet 3:9
- Paul said, "But speak forth the words of truth and soberness." Jn 8:49; Titus 1:9; 2:8

- Paul then proceeded with his preaching to the CONSCIENCE of his audience! Jn 1:9
