Cause of union; cement which unites; link of connection. The highest degree of goodness or holiness of which man is capable in this life.
1 Corinthians	s 13:1	"Though I speak with the tongues of men and angels, and have not charity , <u>I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling</u> <u>cymbal</u> ."
NOTE		ight be the most eloquent communicator on planet earth, but if not have charity, people will never listen to what you have to say.
1 Corinthians	s 13:2	"And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity , <u>I am nothing</u> ."
NOTE		ight have more Bible knowledge than most people, but if you do ve charity, all that information has not made you Christ-like.
1 Corinthians	s 13:3	"And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity , <u>it profiteth me</u> <u>nothing</u> ."
NOTE		ay be inclined to give your money/stuff away or be a martyr for out if you do not have charity, your motives are selfish and wrong.
1 Corinthians	s 13:4-8	"Charity SUFFERETH LONG, and is KIND; charity ENVIETH NOT; charity VAUNTETH NOT ITSELF, is NOT PUFFED UP. Doth NOT BEHAVE itself UNSEEMLY, SEEKETH NOT HER OWN, is NOT EASILY PROVOKED, THINKETH NO EVIL; REJOICETH NOT in INIQUITY, but REJOICETH in the TRUTH; BEARETH all things,

BELIEVETH all things,

HOPETH all things, ENDURETH all things. Charity NEVER FAILETH..."

1 Corinthians 13:13 *"And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the GREATEST of these is CHARITY."*

- NOTE Is it not hard to see how charity is called by God the "*bond of perfectness*"? This chapter is often read at weddings. Do you see your Saviour's love in it? In Luke 10:37, Jesus said, "*Go, and do thou likewise*." (re: good Samaritan)
- Verse 15 And LET the PEACE OF GOD *rule* in your **hearts**, to the which also YE are called in one body; and BE YE THANKFUL.

PeaceFreedom from disturbance or agitation by the passions, as from fear, terror,
anxiety or the like; quietness of mind; tranquility; calmness; quiet of conscience.RuleTo govern; to control the will and actions, either by authority or established laws

Psalm 29:11"The LORD will bless his people with peace."Isaiah 26:3"Thou wilt KEEP him in perfect peace, whose mind is STAYED
on thee: because he TRUSTETH in thee."

- NOTE Can you see how the peace of God ruling would bring thankfulness in our world? If you are saved, you have it IN YOU the Spirit of Christ **IS** PEACE!
- Verse 16 LET the WORD OF CHRIST <u>dwell</u> in you richly in all wisdom; TEACHING and ADMONISHING one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, SINGING with GRACE in your hearts TO THE LORD.

- NOTE What would happen if EVERTHING we did was FOR CHRIST'S GLORY and with a THANKFUL and HUMBLE heart?? God would surely get MORE glory!!
