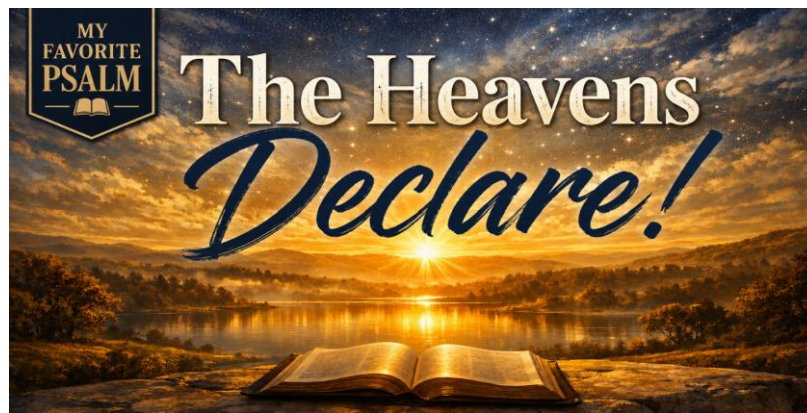




My Favorite Psalm – Psalm 19

- The Heavens and the _____ were created and put in place by God
 - Waters placed above and below - **Gen. 1:1-9**, Gen 2:1-4, Psalm 148:4
 - God placed the sun to move in such a way that we would have day and night – Eccl.1:4-7
 - ◆ Have you ever watched thew sunrise or sunset and felt like it was speaking to you? Absolute Perfect preaching – declaring the Gospel!
 - ◆ No one is without excuse – Eph. 5:19-21. Romans 1:20
 - ◆ The bridegroom coming out of the chamber is a glorious picture of Jesus coming to get The church, His bride! – 1 Thes. 4:13-18 when the trumpet sounds and we are raptured to meet Jesus at the Marriage Feast! AMEN!

➤ Psalm 19:7-10

- The Law of the Lord is perfect – it converts the Soul
 - The Law _____ the soul; it was given to bring us unto Christ. Gal.3:24-25
 - The Law is the basis of truth, _____ matters! 2 Tim. 4:2-3, Titus 1:9
 - Jesus said he came not to destroy the Law but to fulfill it. Matt. 5:17
- The Testimony of the Lord is sure – Makes the simple wise
 - The Bible speaks of the foolish man – 5 times in the KJV Bible. Job 5:2, Ps. 74:22, Proverbs 14:7; 21:20, Matt. 7:26
 - ◆ He says in his heart there is no God – Ps. 14:1, 53:1
 - The Bible speaks of the Wise – 28 times in the KJV Bible Proverbs 14:16; 16:14; 21:20,22; 28:11; Matt. 7:24

- The Statutes of the Lord are right – Rejoicing the Heart
 - The Bible speaks of rejoicing 28 times in KJV Bible
Proverbs 8:30, Jeremiah 15:16, Rom. 12:12, 1 Thess. 2:19
- The Commandment of the Lord is pure – enlightening the eyes – Psalm 111:7
 - We are commanded to _____ one another!
Mark 12:29-31
 - We are commanded to Go!
 - ♦ Preach and Teach all nations
 - ♦ Lead them to Salvation and Baptize them
 - Acts 26:18 – To open their eyes
 - turn them from darkness to light
 - help them receive forgiveness of sins and the inheritance of them that are sanctified by faith.
- The Fear of the Lord is clean – enduring forever – Psalm 111:10
 - God’s Mercy and Love are Eternal - Ps. 103:17
 - We are sealed until the day of redemption – 2 Cor. 1:22; Eph. 1:13, 4:30
- The Judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether
 - More desirable than Gold – even fine Gold
Proverbs 3:13-19, Ps. 119:127, 1 Peter 1:7
 - Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb!

 - Keep back thy servant from presumptuous sins; (definition: much, excess)
 - Let them not have dominion over me:
 - Then shall I be upright
 - And I shall be innocent from the great transgression.
 - Let the words of my mouth,
 - And the meditation of my heart,
 - Be acceptable in thy sight,
 - O LORD,
 - My strength, (My Rock! My Sure Foundation) - Isaiah 28:16, 2 Timothy 2:19
 - And my redeemer. Isaiah 47:4
