II. Foundational principles of Bible study

- 1. The Bible is ______ difficult to understand. We make it difficult by ______ believing every word we read.
 - 2 Peter 3:16 ... in which are some things hard to be understood...
 - 2 Cor 11:1-3 ...as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty...simplicity that is in Christ.
 - Gen 2:16-1 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying...
 - Genesis 3:1-3 Now the serpent was more subtil...Yea, hath God said... (Questions)
 - Genesis 3:4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: (Contradicts)
 - Genesis 3:5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof... (Changes)

Note: Why? Satan understands something...

- 1 Thess 2:13 ... when ye received the word of God... ye received it... as it is in truth, the word of God...
- 2. Anyone can get a working knowledge of the Bible if they want it. There is _____ special secret, _____ magic formula. An education may be helpful, but it is ______ necessary. Knowledge of other languages can be helpful, but it is ______ necessary.

The disciples were common men, not scholars.

Mark 12:37 ... And the common people heard him gladly.

Rev 2:6 ...thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitanes, which I also hate.

Rev 2:15 ... the doctrine of the Nicolaitanes, which thing I hate.

God wrote the Bible to reveal truth, not hide it.

- Ps 119:105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- Ps 119:130 The entrance of thy words giveth light...

Prov 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp, and the law is light...

3. The Holy Spirit teaches the Bible. God can and will use other instruments (preachers, Bible teachers, tapes, CD's, books, etc.), but all truth is imparted by the Holy Spirit. How much you learn depends ______ on your responsiveness to Him.

Note: I will not teach you anything throughout this class series. What you learn will depend on your reliance upon the Holy Spirit to be your teacher as you – by faith – believe what the Bible clearly says.

John 14:16, 26But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost...he shall teach you all things....

John 16:7-13 ... Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth...

1 Cor 2:9-16 ... but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual...

Note: Only the Holy Ghost can reveal truth...

In this respect, God did not author a Bible that anyone could understand!

- 4. Why are there "rules" of Bible study?
 - There are rules to just about everything else ...
 - 1 Cor 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.

...governmental operation, traffic, medicine, mechanics, engineering, sports, cooking, nature (gravity), life (golden rule, etc.)...everything! Think about it...when people come to the living, eternal Word of God, then we throw the rules out the window! No! This violates common sense and logic!

During this study, we will be looking at _____ basic rules (there are more)...these rules come from the Bible itself, and just good, sound, common sense!

• The study of scriptural interpretation is called HERMENEUTICS.

It is the science of interpreting the Bible. It is a man-made term. It is important to know it for future reference.
