# INTRODUCTION

Last week, we learned about the Lord's vessel. Our Lord has commanded us to be *a vessel unto honour*. The God who made you also wants to use you for His glory! Today, we will be reminded that we are **SERVANTS** of the Lord. And our marching orders from the Master are clear. The servant of the Lord *must* seek to free the captives. There is one big problem; they do not **KNOW** they are captives! Their thinking is bad, and they are self-destructing. They have been *taken captive* by the devil *at his will*. This is going to be one of your life's most **IMPORTANT** challenges. This is God's message to you today...

# A. The Text 2 Timothy 2:23-26

#1. The Servant – as a Christian, you are the <u>SERVANT</u> of the Lord.

# THE SERVANT OF THE LORD

#### W1828 "Servant"

A person that attends another to accomplish his purposes.
The subjection to a master for a servant is voluntary (a slave is not).

W1828 "Strife" Exertion or

Exertion or contention for superiority; contention in anger or enmity.

er or enmity.

W1828 "Apt"

Fit; suitable;

inclined; ready; quick.

- ✓ You are called the **SERVANT** of the Lord. **Deut 34:5; Josh 1:1-2; Rom 1:1; Rev 1:1**
- ✓ You are *not* called a **SLAVE** of the Lord. *Jer 2:14* (only 1 time in KJV... NIV 85x, NKJV 31x)
- ✓ Your SUBJECTION to *your* Master is **VOLUNTARY**. *Lk 9:23; Gal 6:7, 8; Heb 12:6, 7*
- ✓ Your SERVICE to *your* Master will be **REWARDED**. *Rom* 14:10; 2Cor 5:10

# **MUST NOT STRIVE**

- ✓ You are to avoid **FOOLISH** questions. **Prov 26:4-5; Gen 4:17** (like where Cain got his wife)
  - There are questions truly seeking answers; there are some that do not (evil motive).
- ✓ You are to avoid **STRIFE**. **1Tim 1:4;4:7;6:4,5; 2Tim 2:14,16; Titus 3:9** (unprofitable/vain)
  - You must NOT strive. Your flesh likes to strive; the Holy Spirit does not strive.
- ✓ You are to be **GENTLE** unto <u>all</u> men. **1Ths 2:7** (as a nurse cherisheth); **Titus 3:2; Jas 3:17** 
  - The wisdom that is from above is pure, peaceable, gentle and easy to be intreated.
- ✓ You are to be **READY** to TEACH truth from the word of God. **2Tim 2:2, 15; 1Pet 3:15** 
  - You must learn the Bible and prepare to teach others truth and things you were taught.
- ✓ You are to be <u>PATIENT</u> with UNKIND and EVIL people. Lk 6:35; Gal 5:22-23
  - The Holy Spirit brings long suffering; our God is kind to the unthankful and to the evil.

**NOTE** As servants of the Lord, we represent Him; He is humble and ready to save.

# #2. The Service – the Master has commanded you to TEACH all nations.

# IN MEEKNESS INSTRUCTING THOSE THAT OPPOSE THEMSELVES

W1828 "Meekness"
Softness of temper;
forbearance under
injuries and
provocations.
Meekness is part of
the Holy Spirit's fruit.

- ✓ The required character is **MEEKNESS**. **Num 12:3** (Moses); **Mt 11:29** (Jesus); **Jas 3:13** 
  - The associated risks include provocations, injuries, and death. Mt 5:11
- ✓ It will sometimes feel <u>like</u> counseling <u>CRAZY</u> people! *Mt 4:24; 17:15* (a lunatick)
- ✓ These people are at ODDS with THEMSELVES! Ps 2:1
  - Their **THIINKING** does not make sense. *Isa* 1:18-20
  - They are **DECEIVED** and do not know it. **2Cor 4:4**
  - Their life **DECISIONS** are leading them astray. *Isa* 53:6
  - They are **DESTROYING** their lives. *Rom 6:23; Jas 1:15*

# "Oppose themselves" To oppose oneself is to be one's own worst enemy. Modern versions translate it as outward, opposing certain things or people. The KJV is correct where the opposition is inward "toward the self." The consequence is destructive.

# **IF GOD PERADVENTURE**

- ✓ Consider how Abraham pleaded with God to spare Sodom. *Gen 18:24; 2Pet 3:9*
- ✓ They <u>must</u> ACKNOWLEDGE the truth and their sin against God. **Ps 51:3-4**
- ✓ They <u>must</u> HUMBLE themselves and REPENT. *Jn 1:12; Acts 17:30-31; Rom 10:9-13* 
  - Our goal is not for them to just pray a prayer.
  - Our goal is for them to surrender all to the Lord Jesus Christ.

**NOTE** Remember, there are <u>no</u> atheists! A FOOL says in his heart there is no God!

# #3. The Snare – they have been taken captive by the <u>DEVIL</u> at his will!

#### **RECOVER THEMSELVES**

- ✓ They are in bondage to sin, without Christ, and with no hope in this world! *Eph 2:12*
- ✓ They are in bondage to the fear of death! *Heb 2:14-18*
- ✓ Jesus Christ died and lives to MAKE them FREE indeed! John 8:31-36; 1John 3:8
- ✓ Jesus Christ endured the CROSS and DESPISED the shame for them! Heb 12:1-3

# THE SNARE OF THE DEVIL

- W1828 "Snare" An instrument for catching one's prey.
- ✓ Consider these NT stories...
  - Mk 9:20-27; 5:1-17; Lk 8:29 Jesus said... Mt 17:21; Mk 9:29 (prayer, fasting)

#### TAKEN CAPTIVE BY HIM AT HIS WILL

✓ The Devil will stop at **NOTHING** to keep people snared and in bondage. **Psalm 126:5** 

**NOTE** You must weep, pray, and fast to God and TRY to free and save the captives!
