1 Cor 3:12

You are God's building.

¹⁰ Because of God's grace to me, I have laid the foundation like an expert builder. Now others are building on it. But whoever is building on this foundation must be very careful. ¹¹ For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have—Jesus Christ.

¹² Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. ¹³ But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value. ¹⁴ If the work survives, that builder will receive a reward. ¹⁵ But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames.

¹⁶ Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you? ¹⁷ God will destroy anyone who destroys this temple. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

¹⁸ Stop deceiving yourselves. If you think you are wise by this world's standards, you need to become a fool to be truly wise. ¹⁹ For the wisdom of this world is foolishness to God. As the Scriptures say,

“He traps the wise
in the snare of their own cleverness.” ²⁰ And again, “The LORD knows the thoughts of the wise;
he knows they are worthless.”

²¹ So don't boast about following a particular human leader. For everything belongs to you—²² whether Paul or Apollos or Peter, or the world, or life and death, or the present and the future. Everything belongs to you, ²³ and you belong to Christ, and Christ belongs to God.

Foundation

1: the act of founding “They've been here since the *foundation* of the school”

2: a basis (such as a tenet, principle, or axiom) upon which something stands or is supported “the *foundations* of geometry” “the rumor is without *foundation* in fact”

1 Now is the time for us to progress beyond the basic message of Christ and advance into perfection. The foundation has already been laid for us to build upon: turning away from our dead works to embrace faith in God, 2teaching about different baptisms, impartation by the laying on of hands, resurrection of

the dead, and eternal judgment. 3So with God's enablement we will move on to deeper truths.

FOUNDATION POINTS:

Your Foundation is the most important part of your Spiritual Temple as a New Creation.

Your Foundation doesn't determine your salvation, but your Foundation WILL determine your Spiritual Elevation

(1 cor 3:12) (2 Tim 2:20)

²⁰ But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. ²¹ Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work. ²² Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart. ²³ But avoid foolish and ignorant disputes, knowing that they generate strife. ²⁴ And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all,

Your Foundation will determine your Elevation.

A weak Foundation will only produce a life of constant Frustration.

Without a strong Foundation, you will suffer Spiritual Stagnation and Starvation.

Your Foundation will determine the Gospels Translation.

Do not be deceived, a weak Foundation left weak on purpose is Flirtation with the enemy.

Cracks in your Foundation become a place of Germination for seeds of compromise from the enemy.

Not repairing a weak Foundation makes a Donation to Compromise that WILL produce fruit.

Cracks in your Foundation that you will not repair produce Spiritual Mutations
