Jer. 17:5-7

⁵ Thus says the Lord:

"Cursed is the man who trusts in man

And makes flesh his strength,

Whose heart departs from the Lord. -

- For he shall be like a **shrub** in the **desert**,
 And shall **not** see when **good** comes,
 But shall **inhabit** the **parched** places in the **wilderness**,
 In a **salt** land which is **not inhabited**.

3 IMPORTANT PARTS OF A FRUIT TREE

- 1. ROOTS
- 2. SHOOTS
- 3. FRUITS

1. ROOTS

Prov. 12:3

A man is not established (made firm) by ungodliness, But the root (deep root)of the righteous cannot be moved. 12:12 But the root(deep root)of the righteous yields *fruit*.

**** Foundation, Most Important part of the Tree

**** The Root structure ALONE determines how tall the Tree can grow and how far it can branch out..

3 different kinds of ROOTS in the Bible

- 1. Root of Bitterness
- 2. Root of Gods Love
- 3. Root of Faith in Jesus

Heb. 12:14

Pursue peace with all *people*, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: ¹⁵ looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any *root of bitterness* springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled; -

///→ 1st kind of ROOT = Bitterness

- 1. Something disagreeable that distresses the mind causing painful or unpleasant emotions
- →Something felt or experienced in a strong and unpleasant way something that is difficult or painful to accept.
- 3: angry or unhappy because of feelings of unfairness or disagreement.
- 4: feeling or showing animosity, cynicism (contemptuously distrustful of human nature and motives) or anger
- --> When **bitterness** comes, **OFFENSE** follows

Luke 17:1-2

Then He said to the disciples, "It is impossible that no offenses should come, but woe *to him* through whom they do come! ² It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were thrown into the sea,

Defiled =

To make unclean, unpure, and to corrupt. To contaminate, to infect by contact or association

contaminated the wound>

Matt. 18:15

¹⁵ "If another believer* sins against you,* go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back. ¹⁶ But if you are unsuccessful, take one or two others with you and go back again, so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses. ¹⁷ If the person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church.-

2nd Kind of Root = Gods Love

Eph 3:17

that <u>Christ may dwell in your hearts</u> through faith; that you, being <u>rooted</u> and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height— ¹⁹ to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. - **NLT**

Your <u>roots</u> will grow down into <u>God's love</u> and keep you strong. ¹⁸ And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. ¹⁹ May you experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully. Then you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God. -

3rd Kind of Root = Faith in Jesus Col.2:6

As you **therefore** have **received** Christ **Jesus** the Lord, so <u>walk</u> in Him, ⁷ rooted and built up in Him <u>and</u> established (secured by the **roots**) <u>of your faith</u>, as you have been taught, abounding in it with <u>thanksgiving</u>.

GOOD ROOTS = GOOD TREE
BAD ROOTS = BAD TREE

**** SO, how do I get rid of the Root of Bitterness??

→ With the roots of **Gods Love** and **Faith in Jesus**, which is held together by **THANKSGIVING**

****Bitterness and Offense are the easy route, the path of least resistance

that sends hard & shallow offshoots in all directions.

Bitterness can <u>only poison</u> the water in the soil and prevent love and grace from soaking in

-->The **only** way **FORWARD** is by going **DEEPER**,

//→ REMEMBER - "(Roots) protect the soil from erosion."

Shoots

→ If a tree is **healthy**, it is **constantly** producing **new shoots** and **branches**.

**** <u>REMEMBER</u> - Trees receive an estimated <u>90</u>% of their nutrition from the atmosphere and only <u>10</u>% from the soil.

**** Your **Shoots** and **branches** can **only grow** when your **roots** are **healthy** and **inward growth** is **happening**

Discipleship

Discipleship is the **process** of **learning** about the **teachings** of **Jesus**, **internalizing** them and then **acting** upon them, through **hands** on **experience**, group **studies** and the **help** of **other believers**.

Branch = .A secondary outgrowth or subdivision of a main axis, a limb.

- 1. A limited part of a larger or more complex unit or system, especially:
- a. <u>An area of specialized skill or knowledge</u>, especially academic or vocational, that is related to but separate from other areas: the judicial branch of government; ex.- the branch of medicine called neurology

1 Thes. 5:11

¹¹So **encourage** each **other** and **build** each other **up**,

**** Jesus was the <u>Ultimate</u> <u>Discipler</u>, He called the 12 to <u>Relationship</u> with **Him** before He called them to action.....

A Decipler (Christian Mentor)

FIRST they are submitted to the Lordship of <u>JESUS</u>, they point you to HIM. not THEM....

- --> **SECOND** they have some **track** record of **success**
- --> THIRDLY They have went through Discipleship themselves, & are walking as a disciple of Jesus.

**** Being **Discipled** is a **CHOICE**......

....you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance, persecutions, afflictions,

3 Purposes of Tree Branches

1. PRODUCE

*** The main trunk just gets thicker each year, but the shoots and branches are how you can really tell the tree is healthy and growing.

Jer 17:7

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Which spreads out its <u>ROOTS</u> by the river, And will not fear when heat comes;
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Heb 13:7

⁷Remember your leaders who taught you the word of God. Think of all the good that has come from their lives, and follow the example of their faith.

***** Areas of DISCIPLESHIP are the BRANCHES of your TREE

- 1. TRUNK = Relationship w/ Jesus
- 2. Marriage
- 3. Relationships
- 4. Character
- 5. Vocation
- 6. Giftings/Calling
- 7. Family
- 8. Christian Disciplines

2. PROVIDE

***** Shoots and Branches are the main source of PROVISION for the tree.

***** REMEMBER = Trees receive an estimated 90% of their nutrition from the atmosphere and only 10% from the soil.

**** There are 2 Factors that effect the growth of a tree branch:

- 1. Light
- 2. Wind
 - --> In our <u>Spiritual</u> Trees, through <u>DISCIPLESHIP</u>, we experience <u>Spiritual</u> <u>Growth</u> through drawing Closer to the <u>light</u> of <u>Jesus</u>...
- --> It's <u>interesting</u> that branches can't <u>share</u> food, but disease will spread to the <u>entire tree</u> and all the branches if not removed <u>immediately</u>.

***** You can't rely on your work in <u>one</u> area of <u>Discipleship</u> to just take care of the others......you need Gods light in <u>EVERY AREA</u> of your life.....

3. PRUNED

<u>John 15:1 -</u> "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. ² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; <u>and every branch that bears</u> <u>fruit He prunes</u>, that it may bear <u>more fruit</u>. ³

You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

⁵ "I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered

It's only **EVERY BRANCH** THAT **BEARS FRUIT** that is **PRUNED**→ **SO** it may bear **MORE FRUIT**!

Proper pruning (<u>training</u>) of young trees is critical. <u>Waiting</u> to prune a tree until it is <u>mature</u> can create the need for <u>larger</u> cuts that the tree <u>cannot</u> easily close.

→ <u>All</u> inward facing shoots must be <u>removed</u>.
