

### **1 John 3:8 (AMP)**

The one who practices sin [separating himself from God, and offending Him by acts of disobedience, indifference, or rebellion] is of the devil [and takes his inner character and moral values from him, not God]; for the devil has sinned *and* violated God's law from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

### **Luke 10:19 (TPT)**

19Now you understand that I have imparted to you all my authority to trample over his kingdom. You will trample upon every demon before you and overcome every power Satan possesses. Absolutely nothing will be able to harm you as you walk in this authority.

### **1 Cor 6:17 (TPT)**

17But the one who joins himself to the Lord is mingled into one spirit with him.

### **2 Cor 10:4 (TPT)**

3-4For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, *using manipulation to achieve our aims*. Instead, our *spiritual* weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses *behind which people hide*.

### **Matt 18:11 (NKJ)**

the Son of Man has come to save that which was lost.

### **Matt 8:17 (TPT)**

And since we are his true children, we qualify to share all his treasures, for indeed, we are heirs of God himself. And since we are joined to Christ, we also inherit all that he is and all that he has. We will experience being co-glorified with him provided that we accept his sufferings as our own.
